Additionally, the bill requires that during the 12 five=year period, the center pursues other options to address 13 the shortage of mental health professionals in the state, 14 including but not limited to utilizing telemedicine and other 15 psychiatric consultation models for primary care providers and 16 other clinicians, and developing new educational programs for 17 health professionals, such as nurse practitioners and 18 physician assistants, with competencies in mental health care. 19 The bill also appropriates funds from the general fund of 20 the state to the board of regents for FY 2007=2008 for

- 2 21 allocation to the university of Iowa hospitals and clinics to 22 increase the number of psychiatry residency positions by 10 2 23 based upon the most recent residency admissions period.
