EXPLANATION

This bill relates to a surviving spouse's elective share 31 involving a revocable trust.

Current law provides that the assets held in a revocable 33 trust created by a deceased spouse during the deceased 34 spouse's lifetime can be included in a surviving spouse's 35 statutory share following the surviving spouse's election 1 against the will of the decedent spouse pursuant to Code 2 section 633.238. The bill provides that such assets held in a 3 revocable trust shall not be subject to a surviving spouse's 4 elective share when the spouse elects to take against the 5 deceased spouse's will.

The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies to all 7 estates of decedents dying on or after September 25, 2003.

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
