1 Section 1. Section 422.7, Code 2007, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 50. If the taxpayer is a licensed
physician, dentist, or optometrist who provides dental or eye services under the medical assistance program and the rate of reimbursement for such dental or eye services is less than the taxpayer normally charges for such services, subtract fifty percent of the difference between the amount normally charged and the reimbursement rate for each dental service or eye
10 service provided which is reimbursed under the medical
assistance program.
Sec. 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY DATE. This Act applies retroactively to January 1, 2007, for tax years beginning on or after that date.

EXPLANATION
This bill provides a deduction in computing individual income tax to a taxpayer that provides dental or eye services reimbursed under the state medical assistance (Medicaid) program. The amount of the deduction equals 50 percent of the difference between the reimbursement rate and the normal fee charged by the taxpayer for the dental service or eye service.

The bill applies retroactively to January 1, 2007, for tax years beginning on or after that date. LSB 2505HH 82
