4 the use and consumption of alcoholic beverages in a public 5 place, the executive council may authorize, by resolution, the 6 temporary use and consumption of alcoholic beverages, as 7 defined in section 123.3, in the state capitol or on the state 8 capitol complex grounds, as if the state capitol or state 9 capitol complex grounds were a private place. The 1 10 authorization by resolution shall be limited to the use and 11 consumption of alcoholic beverages as an accompaniment to food 12 at a single award ceremony, social event, or other occasion 1 13 deemed appropriate by the executive council. The 1 14 authorization shall require that the person providing the food 15 and alcoholic beverages possess an appropriate liquor control 1 16 license in accordance with section 123.95. The secretary of 1 17 the executive council shall inform the director of the 1 18 department of administrative services of the approval of any

EXPLANATION

This bill provides that the executive council may authorize 21 1 22 by resolution the temporary use and consumption of alcoholic 1 23 beverages, as defined in Code section 123.3, in the state 1 24 capitol or on the state capitol complex grounds, as if the 25 state capitol or state capitol complex grounds were a private 26 place. The authorization by resolution shall be limited to 1 27 the use and consumption of alcoholic beverages as an 28 accompaniment to food at a single award ceremony, social 1 29 event, or other occasion deemed appropriate by the executive 1 30 council. The bill specifies that this authorization requires 1 31 that the person providing the food and alcoholic beverages 32 possess an appropriate liquor control license, and that the 33 secretary of the executive council inform the director of the 1 34 department of administrative services of the approval of any 1 35 resolution. 2 1 LSB 2937YH 82
