4 A Resolution to declare the third week of October, 2007, Disability History Week in Iowa. WHEREAS, on July 26, 2006, Americans celebrated the 16th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities

1 8 Act (ADA); and

WHEREAS, since the ADA was enacted into law in 10 1990, many changes have been made, creating a more 11 accessible environment for America's approximately 1 12 51.2 million people with disabilities; and

LENSING, GASKILL, HUNTER, and KRESSIG

WHEREAS, there are almost 400,000 persons with 1 14 disabilities living in Iowa, according to the 2000

1 15 United States Census; and

WHEREAS, this number qualifies persons with 1 17 disabilities as Iowa's largest minority group; and WHEREAS, Americans with disabilities face a 44 1 19 percent unemployment rate; and

WHEREAS, public attitudes continue to stigmatize 21 people with disabilities as being less capable than 1 22 those without disabilities; and

23 WHEREAS, many people with disabilities feel that 24 stigma and therefore are not comfortable talking about 25 their disability; and

WHEREAS, attitudes are formed at a young age; and WHEREAS, the curriculum in many Iowa schools 27 28 includes information about the civil rights movement 29 and women's rights movement, exposing students to the 30 accomplishments of other minority groups; and

WHEREAS, individuals with disabilities have 2 achieved similar victories as a result of the

3 disability rights movement; and

WHEREAS, many famous people, including Ludwig Von 5 Beethoven, Alexander Graham Beil, and Franklin Delano 6 Roosevelt have been people with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, students are not typically exposed to the

8 disability rights movement; and 9 WHEREAS, many Iowa teachers believe that their 2 10 students should learn about the history and 11 accomplishments of individuals with disabilities; and

2 12 WHEREAS, Iowans with disabilities are eager to 2 13 share their history and accomplishments with young 2 14 people; and 2 15 WHEREAS,

WHEREAS, such education will improve public 2 16 attitudes toward individuals with disabilities for 2 17 generations to come; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, 19 That the third week of October, 2007, be declared

2 20 Disability History Week in Iowa; and 2 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Iowa Department of 2 22 Education is requested to encourage schools to conduct 23 disability awareness activities during this week and 24 to work with Iowa disability organizations to develop 25 and disseminate a list of curriculum resources and 2 26 presenters to assist schools in carrying out these 2 27 activities.
