Generally a person who violates a provision of Code chapter 29 206 may be assessed a civil penalty of not more than \$500 for 30 each offense (Code section 206.19) and is guilty of a serious 31 misdemeanor (Code section 206.22). A serious misdemeanor is 32 punishable by confinement for no more than one year and a fine 33 of at least \$315 but not more than \$1,875.
