Section 49.31, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 2007, is amended to read as follows: The commissioner shall determine the order of political parties and nonparty political organizations on the ballot. The sequence shall be the same for each office on the ballot and for each precinct in the county voting in the election. For the order of political parties in successive elections, the commissioner shall alternate the order determined in the last preceding election. A commissioner who succeeds to that office shall discern the order of political parties on the lablot determined by the previous commissioner and shall alternate the order as required by this paragraph. Sec. 2. Section 49.31, Code 2007, is amended by adding the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. 8. For purposes of this section, political party means political party as defined by section 43.2. EXPLANATION This bill requires the commissioner of elections to alternate the order of political parties on the ballot from that used in the previous election. Any commissioner succeeding to that office shall discern the ordering of political parties on the ballot that was utilized by the previous commissioner and shall continue to alternate the order in successive elections. The bill also specifies that "political party" means a party which, at the last preceding general election, cast for its candidate for president of the United States or for governor, as the case may be, at least 2 percent of the total vote cast for all candidates for that office at that election LSB 225988
