A Resolution to recognize Southwest Iowa as the purple
martin region of Iowa.
WHEREAS, the purple martin is the largest and most
beautiful bird of the swallow family; and
WHEREAS, the purple martin feeds entirely on flying
insects, and is an excellent means of natural insect
control as this insect=destroying bird consumes about
2,000 mosquitoes each day; and
WHEREAS, it is known that the purple martin is
clean, graceful in flight, sings beautifully, and
frees picnic areas and patios of insect pests; and
WHEREAS, Mr. Dennis Paul Devine, Sr., a local
citizen of Council Bluffs, Iowa, has worked for 37
years promoting and has sponsored "Purple Martin Time"
four times in Council Bluffs, and with the help of
Griggsville, Illinois, "The Purple Martin" Capital of
the nation, has given six martin houses to the Iowa
School for' the Deaf, Council Bluffs Care Center,
Bethany Lutheran Home, and Bayliss Park in the last 37
years; and
WHEREAS, it would seem altogether fitting and
proper to encourage widespread interest in this most
popular bird, the purple martin; and
WHEREAS, the City of Council Bluffs, Iowa, has had
four "Purple Martin Times" designations in 1978, 1981,
1982, and 1983, signed by four mayors; and
WHEREAS, purple martins return every year to the
area where they hatched and their presence is
beneficial to the community; NOW THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the Senate
recognizes Southwest Iowa as the purple martin region
of Iowa and invites ornithologists and bird=watchers
everywhere to visit Southwest Iowa and view these
remarkable birds.
