EXPLANATION

This bill relates to standards for the performance of certain duties by directors of nonprofit corporations.

Code section 504.831 is amended to require directors to devote attention to their oversight functions with the care that a person in a like position would reasonably believe appropriate under similar circumstances. The bill also authorizes directors to rely on certain information, opinions, reports, or statements presented to them so long as they do not have knowledge that makes the reliance unwarranted.
