Section 86.14, subsection 2, Code 2007, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 2. In a proceeding to reopen an award for payments or 4 agreement for settlement as provided by section 86.13, inquiry 5 shall be into whether or not the condition of the employee 6 warrants an end to, diminishment of, or increase of 7 compensation so awarded or agreed upon. A factor that could 8 have been considered by the parties in assessing the extent of 9 the reduction in the employee's earning capacity and that 1 10 existed or was known about by the parties at the time of the 11 prior award or agreement for settlement shall not bar a 12 proceeding to reopen the award or agreement unless the factor 13 was considered by the parties at the time of the award or 14 agreement and was properly reflected in the amount of 15 compensation paid. Such factors shall include but are not 16 limited to a change in the claimant's underlying medical 17 condition, cessation of accommodation by the claimant's 18 employer, a change in economic factors, or a change in other 19 factors considered in assessing the extent of the reduction in 20 the employee's earning capacity. EXPLANATION 1 21

This bill amends Code section 86.14 to provide that a

1 23 factor that could have been considered in assessing the extent 1 24 of the reduction in the employee's earning capacity and that 25 existed or was known about by the parties at the time of a 26 prior award or agreement for settlement does not bar a

1 27 proceeding to reopen such award or agreement unless the factor

1 28 was considered and properly reflected in the amount of

1 29 compensation paid.
