Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 469.1 DEFINITIONS.
```

For the purposes of this chapter:

- "Council" means the Iowa power fund partnership council 1. 4 created in section 469.4.
- 2. "Director" means the director of renewable energy. "Fund" means the Iowa power fund created in section 6 7 469.5.
- 1 "Office" means the governor's office of renewable 8 1 9 energy.
- 1 10 Sec. 2. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 469.2 OFFICE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY. The office of renewable energy is established in the office 11 1 12 of the governor to coordinate state activities concerning 1 13 renewable energy.
  - <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 469.3 DIRECTOR OF RENEWABLE ENERGY. Sec. 3.
- 1. A director of renewable energy shall be appointed by 1 16 the governor, subject to confirmation by the senate, and shall 1 17 serve at the pleasure of the governor. The governor shall 1 18 fill a vacancy in the office in the same manner as the 1 19 original appointment was made. The director shall be selected 20 primarily for administrative ability and knowledge concerning 21 renewable energy. The salary of the director shall be fixed 1 22 by the governor.
  - 2. The director shall do all of the following:
  - a. Direct the governor's office of renewable energy.
  - b. Manage the Iowa power fund.
  - Lead outreach and public education efforts concerning 27 renewable energy.
- d. Pursue new research and investment funds from federal 1 29 and private sources.
  - e. Coordinate and monitor all existing state and federal 30 31 renewable energy grants and programs.
- 1 32 f. Advise the governor and lieutenant governor concerning 1 33 renewable energy policy and legislation.
  - 34 g. Establish performance measures for determining 35 effectiveness of renewable energy efforts.

- h. Submit an annual report to the governor and general 2 assembly by November 1 of each year concerning the activities 3 and programs of the office, Iowa power fund, and other 4 departments related to renewable energy. The report shall 5 include an assessment of needs with respect to renewable 6 energy efforts.
- i. Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A concerning the 8 office, the Iowa power fund, and the programs and functions of the office and the fund.
- 2 10 NEW SECTION. 469.4 IOWA POWER FUND PARTNERSHIP Sec. 4. COUNCIL.
- 2 1. A nine=member Iowa power fund partnership council is 12 2 13 created with the following membership:
- 2 14 a. The chairperson of the utilities board or the 2 15 chairperson's designee.
- b. The director of the department of economic development 2 17 or the director's designee.
- 2 18 The director of the department of natural resources or 2 19 the director's designee.

2 20 d. Six members appointed by the governor subject to 2 21 confirmation by the senate. An appointee shall have 2 22 demonstrated experience or expertise in one or more of the 23 fields of renewable energy, biofuels, research and development 2 24 of new technologies, commercialization of new technologies, 2 25 and economic development.

2. The members appointed by the governor shall be 27 appointed for three=year staggered terms beginning and ending 2 28 as provided in section 69.19. A vacancy on the council shall 29 be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as the 30 original appointment was made.

3. The members of the council shall be reimbursed for 2 31 2 32 actual and necessary travel and related expenses incurred in 33 the discharge of official duties. Each member of the council 34 may also be eligible to receive compensation as provided in 35 section 7E.6.

- 4. A majority of the members of the council constitutes a quorum, and a majority of the total membership of the council is necessary to act in any matter within the jurisdiction of 4 the council.
  - 5. The duties of the council include all of the following: a. Consider and approve grants, loans, or investments made from the fund.
  - b. Advise the governor and director concerning strategic direction for the fund.
- c. Provide the governor with advice concerning economic 3 11 development, policy, technical issues, and strategic direction concerning renewable energy.

Sec. 5. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 469.5 IOWA POWER FUND.

- The Iowa power fund is created in the state treasury 3 15 under the control of the office. The fund shall be separate 3 16 from the general fund of the state and the balance in the fund 3 17 shall not be considered part of the balance of the general 3 18 fund of the state. However, the fund shall be considered a 3 19 special account for the purposes of section 8.53, relating to 3 20 generally accepted accounting principles.
- 2. The fund shall consist of appropriations made to the 22 fund and other moneys available to and obtained or accepted by 3 23 the office from federal or private sources to the credit of 3 24 the fund. Notwithstanding section 12C.7, subsection 2, 25 interest or earnings on moneys in the fund shall be credited 26 to the fund.
- 3. Moneys available in the fund for a fiscal year are 28 appropriated to the office to be used in developing or 3 29 expanding industries involving renewable energy, alternate 3 30 energy, no or low pollution energy technologies, biofuel, 3 31 energy efficiency, other energy=related approaches, 32 commercializing and increasing the demand for such 33 technologies and approaches, and other purposes designated in 34 law for the fund.
  - Except as otherwise designated by law, the office shall 4. not utilize more than three percent of the amount appropriated from the fund for a fiscal year for administrative costs.
  - 5. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys credited to the Iowa power fund shall not revert to the fund from which appropriated.

Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment. EXPLANATION

This bill creates the governor's office of renewable 10 energy, the position of director of renewable energy, the Iowa 11 power fund partnership council, and the Iowa power fund in new 4 12 Code chapter 469. Duties for the office, director, and 13 council are specified. Grants, loans, and investments made 14 from the fund are subject to approval by the council.

The bill takes effect upon enactment.
