Section 53.2, subsection 2, Code Supplement 1 2 2007, is amended to read as follows: 2. <u>a.</u> The state commissioner shall prescribe a form for 1 3 4 absentee ballot applications. <u>However, if a registered voter</u> 5 submits an application that includes all of the information 1 6 required in this section, the prescribed form is not required. 1 7 <u>b.</u> Absentee ballot applications may include instructions 1 8 to send the application directly to the county commissioner of 1 9 elections. However, no absentee ballot application shall be 1 10 preaddressed or printed with instructions to send the 1 11 applications to anyone other than the appropriate 1 12 commissioner. 1 13 c.
