- 1 A Concurrent Resolution designating May 2010 as
- 2 Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month.
- 3 WHEREAS, motorcycle riding is a popular form of
- 4 recreation and transportation for thousands of people
- 5 across Iowa and the nation; and
- 6 WHEREAS, motorcycle riding can be an enjoyable
- 7 activity when safety is of paramount consideration and
- 8 all laws and regulations are observed; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the safe operation of a motorcycle
- 10 requires the use of special skills developed through a
- 11 combination of training and experience, the use of good
- 12 judgment, and a thorough knowledge of traffic laws and
- 13 licensing requirements; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Motorcycle Safety Awareness Campaign
- 15 is intended to reduce the number of accidents,
- 16 injuries, and fatalities associated with motorcycling
- 17 by encouraging motorcycle operators to participate in
- 18 rider education programs, wear proper apparel, not
- 19 drink and ride, and operate their vehicles defensively
- 20 according to the rules of the road; and
- 21 WHEREAS, motorcycle organizations, clubs,
- 22 dealerships, and groups and highway safety officials in
- 23 our state should join Iowa motorcyclists in actively
- 24 promoting safe motorcycle operation, increased rider

- 25 training, improved licensing efforts, and motorist
- 26 awareness of motorcycles; and
- 27 WHEREAS, the Motorcycle Safety Awareness Campaign
- 28 encourages operators of other motor vehicles to be
 - 1 cautious and observe these smaller vehicles, especially
 - 2 during the seasonal return of motorcycles to Iowa's
 - 3 streets and highways; and
 - 4 WHEREAS, a motorcycle is a vehicle with all of
 - 5 the privileges of any vehicle on the roadway, so a
 - 6 motorcyclist should be allowed the use of a full lane
 - 7 of travel; and
 - 8 WHEREAS, other motorists need to take a second look
- 9 for motorcycles on the highway, at intersections, and
- 10 when a motorcyclist may be changing lanes or making a
- 11 left turn; and
- 12 WHEREAS, other motorists should clearly signal their
- 13 intentions, not follow motorcycles too closely, and
- 14 allow enough room for motorcyclists to take evasive
- 15 action by allowing plenty of space; and
- 16 WHEREAS, obstructions that other motorists might
- 17 ignore, such as debris and potholes, can be deadly
- 18 for a motorcyclist, so other motorists should learn
- 19 to predict when a motorcyclist might take evasive
- 20 action; NOW THEREFORE,
- 21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
- 22 SENATE CONCURRING, That the General Assembly designates
- 23 the month of May 2010 as Motorcycle Safety Awareness
- 24 Month and encourages all Iowa motorists to strive to
- 25 improve motorcycle safety in this state.
