A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act eliminating the continuing education requirement for
- 2 used motor vehicle dealers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 322.7, subsection 4, Code 2009, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 4. The motor vehicle dealer license provided for in this
- 4 chapter shall be renewed upon application in the form and
- 5 content prescribed by the department and upon payment of the
- 6 required fee. A used motor vehicle dealer license shall not be
- 7 renewed for an applicant who is subject to continuing education
- 8 requirements until the licensee certifies completion of the
- 9 educational requirements for license renewal under section
- 10 322.7A. The certification may be transmitted to the department
- 11 by the education provider in electronic format. A licensee
- 12 shall have the month of expiration and the month after the
- 13 month of expiration to renew the license. A person who fails
- 14 to renew a license by the end of this time period and desires
- 15 to hold a license shall file a new license application and pay
- 16 the required fee.
- 17 Sec. 2. Section 322.7A, Code 2009, is amended to read as 18 follows:
- 19 322.7A Used motor vehicle dealer education program.
- 20 1. An applicant for a license as a used motor vehicle dealer
- 21 shall complete a minimum of eight hours of prelicensing used
- 22 motor vehicle dealer education program courses pursuant to this
- 23 section prior to submitting an application to the department.
- 24 2. A person seeking renewal of a used motor vehicle dealer
- 25 license shall complete a minimum of five hours of continuing
- 26 education program courses over a two-year period pursuant to
- 27 this section prior to submitting an application for license
- 28 renewal. However, an applicant for renewal of a used motor
- 29 vehicle dealer license who has met the prelicensing education
- 30 requirement under subsection 1 within the preceding twenty-four
- 31 months is exempt from the continuing education requirement for
- 32 license renewal.
- 33 3. 2. To meet the requirements of this section, at least
- 34 one individual who is associated with the used motor vehicle
- 35 dealer as an owner, principal, corporate officer, director, or

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- 1 member or partner of a limited liability company or limited
- 2 liability partnership shall complete the education program
- 3 courses.
- 4 4. 3. The Iowa independent automobile dealers association,
- 5 in consultation with the state department of transportation,
- 6 the department of education, the attorney general, and the
- 7 Iowa association of community college trustees, shall develop
- 8 the prelicensing and continuing education course curricula
- 9 for the used motor vehicle dealer education program, which
- 10 shall include but not be limited to examination of federal
- 11 and state laws applicable to the motor vehicle industry and
- 12 federal and state regulations pertaining to used motor vehicle
- 13 dealers. The education program courses shall be provided by
- 14 community colleges as defined in section 260C.2 or by the Iowa
- 15 independent automobile dealers association in conjunction
- 16 with a community college. The department of education shall
- 17 adopt rules establishing reasonable fees to be charged
- 18 for the prelicensing education courses and the continuing
- 19 education courses.
- 20 5. 4. A community college shall issue a certificate to
- 21 each person who successfully completes the prelicensing used
- 22 motor vehicle dealer education program or a continuing
- 23 education program under this section. The current certificate
- 24 of completion, or a copy of the certificate, shall be posted
- 25 conspicuously in the principal office of the licensee.
- 26 6. 5. The provisions of this section apply to all
- 27 used motor vehicle dealers, including but not limited to
- 28 individuals, corporations, and partnerships, except for the
- 29 following:
- 30 a. Motor vehicle rental companies having a national
- 31 franchise.
- 32 b. National motor vehicle auction companies.
- 33 c. Wholesale dealer-only auction companies.
- 34 d. Used car dealerships owned by a franchise motor vehicle
- 35 dealer.

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- 1 e. Banks, credit unions, and savings and loan associations.
- 2 7. 6. Each community college providing used motor vehicle
- 3 dealer education program courses shall transmit a report
- 4 on the program annually by December 31 to the director of
- 5 transportation, the director of the department of education,
- 6 the attorney general, and the president of the Iowa association
- 7 of community college trustees.
- 8 EXPLANATION
- 9 This bill eliminates the continuing education requirement
- 10 for used motor vehicle dealers. The used motor vehicle
- 11 dealer education program currently consists of eight hours
- 12 of prelicensing education courses to be completed prior to
- 13 licensure and five hours of continuing education courses
- 14 to be completed over a two-year period prior to license
- 15 renewal. Under the bill, an applicant for a new license is
- 16 still required to complete eight hours of used motor vehicle
- 17 dealer education as a condition for licensure, but there is no
- 18 continuing education requirement for renewal of the license.
