1 An Act relating to treatment procedures for dialysis units. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA: Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 135B.7B Dialysis procedures.
The department shall adopt rules that require dialysis
units, whether part of a hospital or other facility, to
follow attending physician medical procedure or prescriptions
directions for patients, unless the unit is physically unable
to do so.

EXPLANATION

8 A dialysis unit is a facility or part of a facility used 9 for the dialysis of patients with renal conditions. The main 10 type of dialysis carried out in such units is hemodialysis. 11 Patients undergoing hemodialysis usually are treated on 12 an outpatient basis. This bill requires the department of 13 inspections and appeals to adopt rules requiring dialysis 14 units to follow attending physician medical procedure or 15 prescriptions directions for patients.
