A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act imposing an age restriction for motorcycle passengers
- 2 and making a penalty applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.275, subsection 2, paragraph b, Code 2 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. Motorcycles.
- 4 (1) A person shall not operate or ride a motorcycle on
- 5 the highways with another person on the motorcycle unless the
- 6 motorcycle is designed to carry more than one person. The
- 7 additional passenger may ride upon the permanent and regular
- 8 seat if designed for two persons, or upon another seat firmly
- 9 attached to the motorcycle at the rear of the operator. The
- 10 motorcycle shall be equipped with footrests for the passenger
- 11 unless the passenger is riding in a sidecar or enclosed cab.
- 12 The motorcycle operator shall not carry any person nor shall
- 13 any other person ride in a position that will interfere with
- 14 the operation or control of the motorcycle or the view of the
- 15 operator.
- 16 (2) A person shall not operate a motorcycle on the highways
- 17 with another person on the motorcycle who is under twelve years
- 18 of age.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- 20 This bill amends current law concerning the operation
- 21 of motorcycles to prohibit transporting a passenger who is
- 22 under 12 years of age. The provision does not apply when a
- 23 motorcycle is operated in a parade authorized by permit from
- 24 local authorities.
- 25 Under existing law, a person who violates provisions
- 26 relating to the transportation of passengers on a motorcycle
- 27 commits a simple misdemeanor, punishable by a scheduled fine
- 28 of \$25. That penalty is applicable for a violation under the
- 29 bill.
