## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to text messaging and the use of cellular
- 2 telephones by motor vehicle operators and providing a
- 3 penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 2020

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **321.363A** Use of cellular telephones 2 and other devices restricted.
- 3 l. For purposes of this section, the following definitions 4 apply:
- 5 a. "Hands-free mode" means the use of a cellular telephone
- 6 by way of an internal feature or function, or an attachment
- 7 or addition, whether or not permanently part of the cellular
- 8 telephone, by which the user engages in a conversation or
- 9 communication without the use of either hand.
- 10 b. "Public safety agency" means the same as defined in 11 section 34.1.
- 12 c. "Text message" means a text-based electronic
- 13 communication transmitted using the short message service
- 14 (SMS), a wireless telephone service, or an electronic
- 15 communication network.
- 16 d. "Wireless handset" means a handheld portable electronic
- 17 or computing device capable of transmitting data in the form of
- 18 a text message. "Wireless handset" includes but is not limited
- 19 to a cellular telephone or personal digital assistant.
- 20 2. A person shall not operate or use a cellular telephone
- 21 while operating a motor vehicle on a street or highway unless
- 22 the cellular telephone is used in a hands-free mode.
- 23 3. A person shall not use a wireless handset to write, read,
- 24 or send a text message while operating a motor vehicle.
- 25 4. This section does not apply to any of the following:
- 26 a. A member of a public safety agency while using a cellular
- 27 telephone or wireless handset in the performance of the
- 28 member's official duties.
- 29 b. The use of a cellular telephone or wireless handset
- 30 to call 911 or to contact law enforcement authorities or an
- 31 emergency response agency in an emergency situation.
- 32 c. The use of a cellular telephone or wireless handset when
- 33 the motor vehicle is at a complete stop off the roadway.
- 34 5. A person who violates this section commits a simple
- 35 misdemeanor, punishable as a scheduled violation under section

- 2 Sec. 2. Section 805.8A, subsection 6, Code Supplement 2009,
- 3 is amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 4 NEW PARAGRAPH. e. For violations under section 321.363A,
- 5 the scheduled fine is thirty dollars.
- 6 EXPLANATION
- 7 This bill prohibits a person from operating or using a
- 8 cellular telephone while operating a motor vehicle on a
- 9 street or highway unless the cellular telephone is used in a
- 10 hands-free mode.
- 11 The bill also prohibits a person from using a wireless
- 12 handset to write, read, or send a text message while operating
- 13 a motor vehicle.
- 14 The bill defines "hands-free mode" as the use of a cellular
- 15 telephone by way of an internal feature or function, or
- 16 an attachment or addition, by which the user engages in
- 17 a conversation or communication without the use of either
- 18 hand. "Text message" is defined as a text-based electronic
- 19 communication transmitted using the short message service
- 20 (SMS), a wireless telephone service, or an electronic
- 21 communication network. "Wireless handset" is defined as a
- 22 handheld portable electronic or computing device capable of
- 23 transmitting data in the form of a text message. The term
- 24 includes a cellular telephone or personal digital assistant.
- 25 The prohibition does not apply to a member of a public safety
- 26 agency while using a cellular telephone or wireless handset in
- 27 the performance of official duties. In addition, an exception
- 28 is allowed for emergency situations when a cellular telephone
- 29 or wireless handset is used by a driver to call 911 or to
- 30 contact law enforcement authorities or an emergency response
- 31 agency. The bill does not prohibit a driver from using any
- 32 cellular telephone or wireless handset when the motor vehicle
- 33 is at a complete stop off the roadway.
- 34 A violation of the bill is a simple misdemeanor punishable by
- 35 a scheduled fine of \$30.
