## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the license or authorization issued to a
- 2 person who qualifies as a driver education instructor.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.178, subsection 1, paragraphs b and
- 2 c, Code 2009, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. (1) To be qualified as a classroom driver education
- 4 instructor, a person shall have satisfied the educational
- 5 requirements for a teaching license at the elementary or
- 6 secondary level and hold a valid license to teach driver
- 7 education in the public schools of this state.
- 8 (2) (a) Street or highway driving instruction may be
- 9 provided by a person qualified as a classroom driver education
- 10 instructor or a person certified by the department and
- 11 authorized by the board of educational examiners. A person
- 12 shall not be required to hold a current Iowa teacher or
- 13 administrator license at the elementary or secondary level or
- 14 to have satisfied the educational requirements for an Iowa
- 15 teacher license at the elementary or secondary level in order
- 16 to be certified by the department or authorized by the board
- 17 of educational examiners to provide street or highway driving
- 18 instruction.
- 19 (b) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 20 17A to provide for certification of persons qualified to
- 21 provide street or highway driving instruction. The board of
- 22 educational examiners shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 23 17A to provide for authorization of persons certified by the
- 24 department to provide street or highway driving instruction.
- 25 (3) A license or authorization issued by the board of
- 26 educational examiners pursuant to this lettered paragraph shall
- 27 not be denied, suspended, or revoked solely because a person
- 28 is involved in a traffic accident if all of the following
- 29 conditions exist:
- 30 (a) A police authority responded to the traffic accident.
- 31 (b) The department or a police authority has identified the
- 32 site of the traffic accident as a high accident location under
- 33 certain weather conditions or due to construction and such
- 34 condition existed at the time of the traffic accident.
- 35 (c) Two or more parties were cited by the police authority

- 1 for contributing to the accident.
- 2 (d) The department certifies to the board of educational
- 3 examiners that the person has had no other moving violations
- 4 within the past five years on the person's driving record.
- 5 (e) The traffic accident did not result in injury to or the 6 death of a person.
- 7 c. Every public school district in Iowa shall offer or make
- 8 available to all students residing in the school district or
- 9 Iowa students attending a nonpublic school in the district an
- 10 approved course in driver education. The receiving district
- 11 shall be the school district responsible for making driver
- 12 education available to a student participating in open
- 13 enrollment under section 282.18. The courses may be offered
- 14 at sites other than at the public school, including nonpublic
- 15 school facilities within the public school districts. An
- 16 approved course offered during the summer months, on Saturdays,
- 17 after regular school hours during the regular terms or partly
- 18 in one term or summer vacation period and partly in the
- 19 succeeding term or summer vacation period, as the case may
- 20 be, shall satisfy the requirements of this section to the
- 21 same extent as an approved course offered during the regular
- 22 school hours of the school term. A student who successfully
- 23 completes and obtains certification in an approved course in
- 24 driver education or an approved course in motorcycle education
- 25 may, upon proof of such fact, be excused from any field test
- 26 which the student would otherwise be required to take in
- 27 demonstrating the student's ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- 28 A student shall not be excused from any field test if a parent,
- 29 guardian, or instructor requests that a test be administered.
- 30 Street or highway driving instruction may be provided by a
- 31 person qualified as a classroom driver education instructor
- 32 or a person certified by the department and authorized by the
- 33 board of educational examiners. A person shall not be required
- 34 to hold a current Iowa teacher or administrator license at
- 35 the elementary or secondary level or to have satisfied the

1 educational requirements for an Iowa teacher license at the 2 elementary or secondary level in order to be certified by 3 the department or authorized by the board of educational 4 examiners to provide street or highway driving instruction. A 5 final field test prior to a student's completion of an 6 approved course shall be administered by a person qualified 7 as a classroom driver education instructor. The department 8 shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to provide for 9 certification of persons qualified to provide street or highway 10 driving instruction. The board of educational examiners 11 shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to provide for 12 authorization of persons certified by the department to provide 13 street or highway driving instruction. 14 **EXPLANATION** This bill establishes that, when certain conditions exist, 15 16 the license or authorization that the board of educational 17 examiners issues to persons who are qualified as driver 18 education instructors shall not be denied, suspended, 19 or revoked solely because the applicant or license or 20 authorization holder was involved in a traffic accident. 21 The conditions which must exist include all of the 22 following: law enforcement responded to the traffic accident, 23 authorities have identified the area where the accident 24 occurred as a high accident location, two or more parties were 25 cited for contributing to the accident, the department of 26 transportation certifies to the board of educational examiners 27 that the person has had no other moving violations within 28 the past five years on the person's driving record, and the 29 accident did not result in injury to or the death of a person.
