A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to certification requirements related to
- 2 services provided by an assisted living program, and
- 3 including effective date and retroactive applicability
- 4 provisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- Section 1. Section 231C.3, subsection 4, paragraph a, Code 2 Supplement 2009, is amended to read as follows:

 3 a. Services provided by a certified assisted living program
- 4 may be provided directly by \underline{a} person who is staff of the
- 5 assisted living program, by individuals a person contracting
- 6 with the assisted living program to provide services, or by
- 7 individuals a person employed by the tenant or with whom
- 8 the tenant contracts if the tenant agrees to assume the
- 9 responsibility and risk of the employment or the contractual
- 10 relationship. For the purposes of specifying the entity
- ll providing services under this section, "person" means person
- 12 as defined in section 4.1 and includes a corporate parent,
- 13 subsidiary, or affiliate of an assisted living program.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 231C.3, subsection 4, Code Supplement 2009,
- 15 is amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 16 NEW PARAGRAPH. c. Certification of an assisted living
- 17 program shall require that an assisted living program is
- 18 prohibited from ceasing operation as an assisted living program
- 19 if the program provides or continues to provide services which
- 20 meet the definition of assisted living under this chapter by a
- 21 person as specified in paragraph "a". This prohibition shall
- 22 apply to any entity in this state that meets the definition of
- 23 assisted living program on or after July 1, 2009.
- 24 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT AND RETROACTIVE
- 25 APPLICABILITY. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
- 26 takes effect upon enactment and applies retroactively to July
- 27 1, 2009.
- 28 EXPLANATION
- 29 This bill relates to the services provided by an assisted
- 30 living program. The bill provides that services provided
- 31 by a certified assisted living program may be provided by
- 32 persons as specified in the bill and defines "person" to
- 33 mean person as defined in Code section 4.1, which means an
- 34 individual, corporation, limited liability company, government
- 35 or governmental subdivision or agency, business trust, estate,

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- 1 trust, partnership or association, or any other legal entity
- 2 and for the purposes of the bill specifically includes any
- 3 corporate parent, subsidiary, or affiliate of an assisted
- 4 living program.
- 5 The bill also provides that certification of an assisted
- 6 living program requires that an assisted living program is
- 7 prohibited from ceasing operation as an assisted living program
- 8 if the program provides or continues to provide services which
- 9 meet the definition of assisted living under the Code chapter
- 10 by a person as specified under the bill. The prohibition
- ll applies to any entity in this state that meets the definition
- 12 of assisted living program on or after July 1, 2009.
- 13 The bill takes effect upon enactment and is retroactively
- 14 applicable to July 1, 2009.
