# House File 2117 - Introduced

HOUSE FILE 2117 BY T. OLSON

## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act concerning payments for certain dental care services
- 2 including fee schedules for dental services and assignment
- 3 of dental care coverage benefits.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 514C.3B Dental coverage fee 2 schedules.
- 3 l. A contract between a dental plan and a dentist for the
- 4 provision of services to covered individuals under the plan
- 5 shall not require that a dentist provide services to those
- 6 covered individuals at a fee set by the dental plan unless such
- 7 services are covered services under the dental plan.
- 8 2. A person or entity providing third-party administrator
- 9 services shall not make available any dentists in its dentist
- 10 network to a dental plan that does any of the following:
- 11 a. Sets fees for dental services that are not covered
- 12 services.
- 13 b. Sets fees for dental services that exceed the maximum fee
- 14 for dental services covered by the dental plan.
- 15 3. For the purposes of this section:
- 16 a. "Covered services" means services reimbursed under the
- 17 dental plan.
- 18 b. "Dental plan" means any policy or contract of insurance
- 19 which provides for coverage of dental services not in
- 20 connection with a medical plan that provides for the coverage
- 21 of medical services.
- 22 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 514C.3C Assignment of dental care
- 23 coverage benefits.
- 24 l. A carrier as defined in section 513B.2; an organized
- 25 delivery system authorized under 1993 Iowa Acts, ch. 158,
- 26 and licensed by the director of public health; or a plan
- 27 established pursuant to chapter 509A for public employees,
- 28 shall not do either of the following:
- 29 a. Prohibit the assignment of dental care coverage benefits
- 30 to a dental care provider by a covered individual.
- 31 b. Refuse to directly reimburse a dental care provider
- 32 pursuant to a valid assignment of dental care coverage benefits
- 33 after receipt of written notice of the assignment.
- 34 2. An assignment of benefits as described in this section
- 35 shall not affect or limit the payment of benefits otherwise

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- 1 payable under a dental care benefit contract, policy, or plan
- 2 and a covered individual shall not be otherwise penalized for
- 3 making such an assignment of benefits.
- 4 3. A payment of benefits made under a dental care benefit
- 5 contract, policy, or plan prior to receipt of written notice
- 6 of assignment of the benefits shall be without prejudice to
- 7 the payor. This section shall not be construed to prevent the
- 8 reconciliation of erroneous or duplicate payments made.
- 9 4. For the purposes of this section, unless the context
- 10 otherwise requires:
- 11 a. "Assignment of benefits" means the transfer of dental
- 12 care coverage reimbursement benefits or other rights under an
- 13 insurance contract, policy, or plan by a covered individual to
- 14 a dental care provider.
- 15 b. "Dental care provider" means a dentist, dental hygienist,
- 16 or dental assistant registered or licensed to practice under
- 17 chapter 153.
- 18 EXPLANATION
- 19 This bill creates new Code section 514C.3B which prohibits
- 20 a dental plan from setting fee schedules for participating
- 21 dentists for the provision of dental services that are not
- 22 covered by the plan. The bill also prohibits a third-party
- 23 administrator from making a dentist in its provider network
- 24 available to a dental plan that sets fees for services that are
- 25 not covered or sets fees for dental services that exceed the
- 26 maximum fee for dental services covered by the dental plan.
- 27 For the purposes of new Code section 514C.3B, a "covered
- 28 service" is a service reimbursed under the applicable dental
- 29 plan. A "dental plan" is any policy or contract of insurance
- 30 which provides for coverage of dental services not in
- 31 connection with a medical plan which provides for the coverage
- 32 of medical services.
- 33 The bill also creates new Code section 514C.3C which
- 34 prohibits a carrier, organized delivery system, or plan for
- 35 public employees from refusing to allow a covered individual to

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- 1 assign payment of dental care coverage benefits to dental care
- 2 provider, or from refusing to directly reimburse a dental care
- 3 provider, pursuant to a valid assignment of such benefits upon
- 4 receipt of written notice of the assignment.
