A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act prohibiting setting or maintaining traps within a public
- 2 road right-of-way without prior permission of the adjacent
- 3 landowner or tenant and providing a penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 481A.92, subsection 3, Code 2009, is
- 2 amended by striking the subsection and inserting in lieu
- 3 thereof the following:
- 4 3. A person shall not set or maintain any type of snare
- 5 or trap within any public road right-of-way unless the owner
- 6 or tenant of the land adjacent to the public right-of-way has
- 7 given permission.
- 8 EXPLANATION
- 9 This bill prohibits the use of any type of snare or trap
- 10 within any public road right-of-way unless the owner or tenant
- 11 of the land adjacent to the public road right-of-way has
- 12 given permission. Currently, a person must obtain the prior
- 13 permission of the occupant of a residence whose private drive
- 14 entry is within 200 yards of where a conibear-type trap or
- 15 snare will be set.
- "Public road right-of-way" means an area of land, the right
- 17 to possession of which is secured or reserved by the state
- 18 or a governmental subdivision for roadway purposes. The
- 19 right-of-way for all secondary roads is 66 feet in width,
- 20 unless otherwise specified by the county board of supervisors
- 21 of the respective counties.
- 22 A violation of the new provision is punishable by a scheduled
- 23 fine of \$25.
