- 2 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 10. Issue statements of professional recognition to
- 4 school service personnel who have attained a minimum of
- 5 a baccalaureate degree and who are licensed by another
- 6 professional licensing board or agency, including but not
- 7 limited to athletic the following:
- 8 a. Athletic trainers licensed under chapter 152D.
- 9 b. Persons who have met all of the requirements established
- 10 by the United States department of defense and the applicable
- 11 branch of the armed services for serving as an instructor in
- 12 the junior reserve officer training corps program.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- 14 This bill authorizes the board of educational examiners to
- 15 issue statements of professional recognition to persons who
- 16 have at a minimum attained a baccalaureate degree and who have
- 17 met all of the requirements established by the United States
- 18 department of defense and the applicable branch of the armed
- 19 services for serving as an instructor in the junior reserve
- 20 officer training corps program. Persons who hold a statement
- 21 of professional recognition and who meet the requirements
- 22 specified in Code chapter 284, which establishes the student
- 23 achievement and teacher quality program, are eligible to
- 24 receive teacher salary supplement funds.
