- 2 amended to read as follows:

- 8 to the student or otherwise contribute to the learning process,
- 9 or electronic.
- 10 b. Electronic textbooks, including but not limited to
- 11 computer software, applications using computer-assisted
- 12 instruction, interactive videodisc, and other computer
- 13 courseware and magnetic media.
- c. Instructional technology applicable within a classroom
- 15 setting.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- 17 This bill relates to the use of state funds allocated to
- 18 school districts for purposes of making textbooks available to
- 19 accredited nonpublic school pupils by expanding the definition
- 20 of textbooks, and therefore the allowable use of certain state
- 21 funds, to include instructional technology applicable within
- 22 a classroom setting. Currently, the definition is limited to
- 23 books, supplementary instructional materials, and electronic
- 24 textbooks, including but not limited to computer software.
