Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 238.16A Private child-placing
 agency — adoption services eligibility requirements.
 A private child-placing agency licensed to place children
 for adoption may establish and administer eligibility
 requirements for adoptive families that do not conflict with
 religious beliefs or moral convictions to which the agency
 subscribes. Establishing and administering such eligibility
 requirements shall not be grounds for revocation of licensure.
 <u>EXPLANATION</u>
 This bill provides that a private child-placing agency may

11 establish eligibility requirements for adoptive families that
12 do not conflict with the religious beliefs or moral convictions
13 to which the agency subscribes. The bill also provides that
14 establishing and administering such eligibility requirements
15 shall not be grounds for revocation of licensure.
