A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to judicial branch records.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 22.15 Judicial branch — rules.

2 This chapter does not apply to government records owned,
3 created, possessed, or under the control of the judicial
4 branch. The supreme court shall prescribe rules governing
5 access to such records consistent with the provisions of this
6 chapter.

7 Sec. 2. Section 252B.24, subsection 2, paragraph b, Code
8 2009, is amended to read as follows:

9 b. Provision to the unit of information filed with the
10 clerk of the district court by a party under section 598.22B,
11 ~~and the social security number of a child filed with the clerk~~
12 ~~of the district court under section 602.6111.~~

13 Sec. 3. Section 602.6111, Code 2009, is repealed.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill relates to judicial branch records.

16 The bill provides that the provisions of Code chapter 22
17 (Iowa's open records law, relating to the regulation of records
18 of a government body as defined in that chapter) do not apply
19 to government records owned, created, possessed, or under the
20 control of the judicial branch. However, the supreme court is
21 required to prescribe rules governing access to such records
22 consistent with the purposes of Code chapter 22.

23 The bill repeals a Code section requiring that certain
24 identification information be filed with the clerk of the
25 district court including social security numbers and makes a
26 conforming Code change to Code section 252B.24 relating to
27 social security numbers of children in child support recovery
28 cases.
