## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to providing veteran services to inmates
- 2 incarcerated in a jail or municipal holding facility.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 2321

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 356.6A Duty to inform about veteran 2 services.
- 3 The personnel of a jail or municipal holding facility shall
- 4 inform a prisoner, within twenty-four hours of incarceration,
- 5 that if the prisoner is a veteran of the United States military
- 6 forces who has been released from active duty within the
- 7 previous five years, the prisoner may be entitled to a visit
- 8 from a veteran service officer to determine if veteran services
- 9 are required or available. Within twenty-four hours of
- 10 determining a prisoner is a veteran who has been released from
- 11 active duty within the previous five years, the personnel of
- 12 a jail or municipal holding facility shall inform the county
- 13 commission of veteran affairs of the county where the jail or
- 14 facility is located that a prisoner at the jail or facility is
- 15 a veteran and may be entitled to a visit from a veteran service
- 16 officer.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill relates to providing veteran services to inmates
- 19 incarcerated in a jail or municipal holding facility.
- 20 The bill requires the personnel of a jail or municipal
- 21 holding facility, to inform a prisoner, within 24 hours of
- 22 incarceration, that if the prisoner is a veteran who has been
- 23 released from active duty within the previous five years, the
- 24 prisoner may be entitled to a visit from a veteran service
- 25 officer to determine if veteran services are required or
- 26 available.
- 27 If it is determined that the prisoner is a veteran who
- 28 has been released from active duty within the previous five
- 29 years, the bill requires the personnel of the jail or municipal
- 30 holding facility, within 24 hours of making the determination,
- 31 to inform the county commission of veteran affairs of the
- 32 county where the jail or facility is located that a prisoner at
- 33 the jail or facility is a veteran and may be entitled to a visit
- 34 from a veteran service officer.
