A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act creating a mental health workforce loan repayment
- 2 program, providing for contingent implementation, and
- 3 providing for a repeal.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 135.175, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
 Supplement 2009, is amended to read as follows:

a. A health care workforce support initiative is established
4 to provide for the coordination and support of various efforts
5 to address the health care workforce shortage in this state.
6 This initiative shall include the medical residency training
7 state matching grants program created in section 135.176,
8 the health care professional and nursing workforce shortage
9 initiative created in sections 261.128 and 261.129, the safety
10 net provider recruitment and retention initiatives program
11 created in section 135.153A, health care workforce shortage
12 national initiatives, and the physician assistant mental health
13 fellowship program created in section 135.177, and the mental
14 health workforce loan repayment program created in section

15 135.178.

16 Sec. 2. Section 135.175, subsection 5, Code Supplement 17 2009, is amended by adding the following new paragraph: 18 NEW PARAGRAPH. f. The mental health workforce loan repayment 19 program account. The mental health workforce loan repayment 20 program account shall be under the control of the department 21 and the moneys in the account shall be used for the purposes of 22 the mental health workforce loan repayment program as specified 23 in section 135.178. Moneys in the account shall consist of 24 moneys appropriated or allocated for deposit in or received 25 by the fund or the account and specifically dedicated to the 26 mental health workforce loan repayment program or account for 27 the purposes of such account.

28 Sec. 3. Section 135.175, subsection 6, paragraph a, Code 29 Supplement 2009, is amended to read as follows:

30 *a.* Moneys in the fund and the accounts in the fund shall 31 only be appropriated in a manner consistent with the principles 32 specified and the strategic plan developed pursuant to sections 33 135.163 and 135.164 to support the medical residency training 34 state matching grants program, the health care professional 35 incentive payment program, the nurse educator incentive

8 Sec. 4. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 135.178 Mental health workforce loan
9 repayment program — repeal.

10 1. The department, in cooperation with the college student ll aid commission, shall establish a mental health workforce 12 loan repayment program in accordance with this section. 13 Funding for the program may be provided through the health 14 care workforce shortage fund or the mental health workforce 15 loan repayment program account created in section 135.175. 16 The purpose of the program is to increase the number of 17 physicians, physician assistants, and advanced registered 18 nurse practitioners providing mental health services in mental 19 health professional shortage areas as defined in section 20 135.80. Under the program, loan repayment may be made to a 21 recipient for educational expenses incurred while completing 22 an accredited health education program directly related to 23 obtaining credentials necessary to provide mental health 24 services in accordance with the individual's profession. 25 2. The department, in cooperation with the college student 26 aid commission, shall adopt rules relating to the establishment 27 and administration of the mental health workforce loan 28 repayment program. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection 29 shall provide, at a minimum, for all of the following: 30 Determination of eligibility requirements and a. 31 qualifications of an applicant to receive loan repayment under 32 the program, including but not limited to years of obligated 33 service, clinical practice requirements, and residency 34 requirements. One year of obligated service shall be provided 35 by the applicant in exchange for each year of loan repayment,

unless federal requirements otherwise require. Loan repayment
 under the program shall not be approved for a health provider
 whose license or certification is restricted by a medical
 regulatory authority of any jurisdiction of the United States,
 other nations, or territories.

b. Identification of mental health professional shortage
7 areas as defined in section 135.80 in the state and
8 prioritization of such areas according to need.

9 c. Determination of the amount and duration of the loan 10 repayment an applicant may receive, giving consideration to the 11 availability of funds under the program, and the applicant's 12 outstanding educational loans and professional credentials.

d. Determination of the conditions of loan repayment
 applicable to an applicant.

15 e. Enforcement of the state's rights under a loan repayment 16 program contract, including the commencement of any court 17 action.

18 f. Cancellation of a loan repayment program contract for 19 reasonable cause.

3. The department may enter into an agreement under chapter 28E with the college student aid commission for the administration of this program.

23 4. This section is repealed June 30, 2014.

24 Sec. 5. IMPLEMENTATION. This Act shall be implemented only 25 to the extent funding is available.

EXPLANATION

This bill creates a mental health workforce loan repayment program as part of the health care workforce support initiative, and also creates an account for the program within the health care workforce shortage fund.

The bill directs the department of public health (DPH), in cooperation with the college student aid commission, so establish the program. Funding for the program may be provided through the health care workforce shortage fund or the mental health workforce loan repayment program account.

1 The purpose of the program is to increase the number of 2 physicians, physician assistants, and advanced registered nurse 3 practitioners providing mental health services in federally 4 designated mental health workforce shortage areas. Under 5 the program, loan repayment may be made to a recipient for 6 educational expenses incurred while completing an accredited 7 health education program directly related to obtaining 8 credentials necessary to provide mental health services.

9 DPH is directed, in cooperation with the college student 10 aid commission, to adopt rules relating to the establishment 11 and administration of the program, including eligibility 12 requirements and qualifications of an applicant to receive loan 13 repayment, including but not limited to years of obligated 14 service, clinical practice requirements, and residency 15 requirements; identification of federally designated mental 16 health shortage areas of the state and prioritization of 17 such areas according to need; determination of the amount 18 and duration of the loan repayment an applicant may receive; 19 determination of the conditions of loan repayment applicable 20 to an applicant; enforcement of the state's rights under a 21 loan repayment program contract; and cancellation of a loan 22 repayment program contract for reasonable cause. DPH may enter 23 into an agreement under Code chapter 28E with the college 24 student aid commission for the administration of this program. 25 Implementation of the program is contingent on the extent of 26 available funding, and the program is repealed June 30, 2014.
