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A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing financial support from the community
- 2 attraction and tourism fund for regional ethnic festivals
- 3 and making appropriations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 15F.204, subsection 5, unnumbered
- 2 paragraph 1, Code Supplement 2009, is amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 At the beginning of each fiscal year, the board shall
- 5 allocate one hundred thousand dollars for purposes of marketing
- 6 those projects that are receiving moneys from the fund and
- 7 five hundred thousand dollars for purposes of supporting
- 8 regional ethnic festivals pursuant to section 15F.207. After
- 9 the marketing allocation and the regional ethnic festivals
- 10 allocation, the board shall allocate all remaining moneys in
- 11 the fund in the following manner:
- 12 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 15F.207 Regional ethnic festivals —
- 13 applications.
- 14 l. a. The department shall accept applications for
- 15 financial assistance from the organizers of regional ethnic
- 16 festivals. The applications shall be analyzed and evaluated in
- 17 substantially the same manner as provided in section 15F.206,
- 18 subsection 1. The department, in coordination with the board,
- 19 shall adopt rules governing the application and awards process.
- 20 b. The financial assistance shall be provided from the
- 21 moneys allocated for such purposes pursuant to section 15F.204,
- 22 subsection 5. The amount of financial assistance awarded to
- 23 an applicant under this section shall not exceed one hundred
- 24 thousand dollars.
- 25 2. To be eligible for financial assistance under this
- 26 section, an applicant shall be a nonprofit entity exempt from
- 27 federal income taxation pursuant to section 501(c)(3) of the
- 28 Internal Revenue Code, shall demonstrate that the festival
- 29 would generate a significant amount of cultural and tourism
- 30 opportunities within a community, and shall demonstrate the
- 31 participation of at least four of the following:
- 32 *a.* A city.
- 33 b. A county.
- 34 c. Two or more schools from a local school district.
- 35 d. A community college.

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- 1 e. A private college or a board of regents institution.
- 2 f. An entity with a focus on cultural attraction or 3 promotion.
- 4 g. A historical society.
- 5 h. One or more businesses.
- 6 EXPLANATION
- 7 This bill relates to the allocation of moneys in the
- 8 community attraction and tourism fund for regional ethnic
- 9 festivals.
- 10 The bill directs the vision Iowa board to annually allocate
- 11 \$500,000 of the moneys in the fund, before making the other
- 12 statutory allocations, for purposes of providing financial
- 13 support to regional ethnic festivals.
- 14 The bill provides for an application evaluation process that
- 15 is substantially the same as the existing process for applying
- 16 to the board for river enhancement community attraction and
- 17 tourism moneys. In order to receive financial assistance,
- 18 an applicant must be a nonprofit entity, must show that
- 19 the festival will create significant cultural and tourism
- 20 opportunities in a community, and must have the participation
- 21 of at least four other local community entities including city
- 22 or county governments, schools, private colleges, universities,
- 23 historical societies, cultural entities, or businesses.
