## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to criminal offense definitions, penalties, and
- 2 the forfeiture of an unsecured appearance bond in a criminal
- 3 proceeding.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

#### H.F. 2473

- 1 Section 1. Section 716.6, subsection 1, Code Supplement
- 2 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 1.  $\underline{a}$ . Criminal mischief is criminal mischief in the fourth
- 4 degree if the any of the following apply:
- 5 (1) The cost of replacing, repairing, or restoring the
- 6 property so damaged, defaced, altered, or destroyed exceeds two
- 7 hundred dollars, but does not exceed five hundred dollars.
- 8 (2) The person intentionally injures, destroys, disturbs,
- 9 or removes any marker placed on any tract of land, street,
- 10 or highway, designating any point, course, or line on the
- 11 boundary of the tract of land, street, or highway, if the
- 12 marker was placed at such location by a land surveyor licensed
- 13 under chapter 542B, or by any person directed by a licensed
- 14 land surveyor. A governmental entity and employees of such
- 15 an entity are exempt from prosecution under this subparagraph
- 16 for projects performed pursuant to section 314.8. A licensed
- 17 land surveyor and persons under the direction of a licensed
- 18 land surveyor are also exempt from prosecution under this
- 19 subparagraph for removing an existing marker in order to place
- 20 an upgraded or more suitable marker in the same location.
- 21 (3) The person intentionally injures, destroys, disturbs,
- 22 or removes any monument that has been established by the
- 23 national geodetic survey, Iowa geodetic survey, or any county
- 24 geographic information system for use in the determination of
- 25 spatial location relative to the specified Iowa state plane
- 26 coordinate system or precise elevation datum. A governmental
- 27 entity and employees of such an entity are exempt from
- 28 prosecution under this subparagraph for projects performed
- 29 pursuant to section 314.8.
- 30 b. Criminal mischief in the fourth degree is a serious
- 31 misdemeanor.
- 32 Sec. 2. Section 811.9, Code Supplement 2009, is amended to
- 33 read as follows:
- 34 811.9 Forfeiture of appearance bond.
- 35 Sections 811.6 through 811.8 shall not apply in a case where

- 1 a simple misdemeanor is charged upon a uniform citation and
  2 complaint and where the defendant has submitted an unsecured
  3 appearance bond or has submitted bail in the form of cash,
  4 check, credit card as provided in section 805.14, or guaranteed
  5 arrest bond certificate as defined in section 321.1. When a
  6 defendant fails to appear as required in such cases, the court,
  7 or the clerk of the district court, shall enter a judgment of
  8 forfeiture of the bond or bail. The judgment shall be final
  9 upon entry and shall not be set aside unless a conviction for a
  10 scheduled violation under chapter 321 was set aside under the
  11 procedures established in section 321.200A, or upon a showing
  12 of good cause after the filing of a motion within ninety days
  13 of entry of the judgment, for mistake, inadvertence, surprise,
  14 excusable neglect, or unavoidable casualty.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- 16 This bill expands the definition of criminal mischief in the 17 fourth degree.
- A person commits criminal mischief in the fourth degree
- 19 under the bill if the person intentionally injures, destroys,
- 20 disturbs, or removes any marker placed on any tract of land,
- 21 street, or highway, designating any point, course, or line on
- 22 the boundary of the tract of land, street, or highway, and the
- 23 marker was placed at such location by a licensed land surveyor,
- 24 or by any person directed by a licensed land surveyor. A
- 25 governmental entity and employees of such an entity are exempt
- 26 from prosecution under the bill for projects performed pursuant
- 27 to Code section 314.8, relating to preservation of government
- 28 markers in the course of highway construction. A licensed land
- 29 surveyor and persons under the direction of the surveyor are
- 30 also exempt from prosecution under the bill for removing an
- 31 existing marker in order to place an upgraded or more suitable
- 32 marker in the same location.
- 33 A person also commits criminal mischief in the fourth
- 34 degree under the bill if the person intentionally injures,
- 35 destroys, disturbs, or removes any monument that has been

- 1 established by the national geodetic survey, Iowa geodetic
- 2 survey, or any county geographic information system for use in
- 3 the determination of spatial location relative to the specified
- 4 Iowa state plane coordinate system or precise elevation datum.
- 5 A governmental entity and employees of such an entity are
- 6 exempt from prosecution under the bill for projects performed
- 7 pursuant to Code section 314.8.
- 8 A person who commits criminal mischief in the fourth degree
- 9 commits a serious misdemeanor. A serious misdemeanor is
- 10 punishable by confinement for no more than one years and a fine
- 11 of at least \$315 but not more than \$1,875.
- 12 The bill also allows the forfeiture of an unsecured
- 13 appearance bond for a simple misdemeanor to be set aside upon
- 14 a showing of good cause, if a motion is filed within 90 days
- 15 of the entry of the judgment of forfeiture. The bill limits
- 16 a good cause showing to mistake, inadvertence, surprise,
- 17 excusable neglect, or unavoidable casualty.
