A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing an Iowa financial literacy program within
- 2 the office of the treasurer of state.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 12G.1 Iowa financial literacy
 2 program legislative intent.
- 3 The general assembly finds that the general welfare of this
- 4 state and well-being of its citizens is directly related to
- 5 the financial education of those citizens. While the state
- 6 has limited resources to promote financial literacy, a vital
- 7 and valid public purpose shall be served by the creation
- 8 and implementation of programs which encourage and make
- 9 possible the attainment of financial literacy by the largest
- 10 possible number of citizens in this state, and particularly by
- 11 low-income to moderate-income families.
- 12 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 12G.2 Program created.
- 13 An Iowa financial literacy program is created within the
- 14 office of the treasurer of state. The treasurer of state shall
- 15 have all powers necessary to carry out and effectuate the
- 16 purposes, objectives, and provisions pertaining to the program,
- 17 including the authority to do all of the following:
- 18 1. Promote the advantages of personal savings and the
- 19 viability and desirability of implementing a personal savings
- 20 program regardless of an individual's or family's financial
- 21 status.
- 22 2. Create an incentive program and awards ceremony whereby
- 23 individuals and families who have made significant progress
- 24 toward achieving personal savings goals shall be officially
- 25 recognized.
- 26 3. Create strategies for coordination of the program with
- 27 the Iowa educational savings plan trust established in chapter
- 28 12D.
- 29 4. Make presentations to groups including but not limited
- 30 to schools, hospitals, civic organizations, and privately
- 31 organized clubs and groups regarding the existence of the
- 32 program.
- 33 5. Coordinate conferences, meetings, and events which
- 34 promote financial literacy and education.
- 35 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 12G.3 Funding.

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- The treasurer of state may utilize and allocate any funds 2 legally available for purposes of promoting financial literacy 3 to administer the program created in section 12G.2, and shall
- 4 submit a report to the governor and the general assembly
- 5 regarding the program on an annual basis.
- 6 EXPLANATION
- 7 This bill provides for the establishment of a financial
- 8 literacy program within the office of the treasurer of state.
- 9 The objective of the program shall be to encourage and make
- 10 possible the achievement of financial literacy by the largest
- 11 number of citizens in Iowa, and especially by low to moderate
- 12 income families.
- 13 The bill provides that the state treasurer shall be
- 14 authorized to promote the advantages of personal savings and
- 15 the viability and desirability of implementing a personal
- 16 savings program regardless of an individual's or a family's
- 17 financial status; to create an incentive program and awards
- 18 ceremony recognizing individuals and families who have made
- 19 significant progress toward achieving personal savings goals;
- 20 to create strategies for coordination of the program with the
- 21 Iowa educational savings plan trust; to make presentations to
- 22 schools, hospitals, civic organizations, privately organized
- 23 clubs and groups and other groups regarding the existence of
- 24 the program; and to coordinate conferences, meetings, and
- 25 events promoting financial literacy and education.
- 26 The bill allows the treasurer of state to utilize and
- 27 allocate any funds legally available for purposes of promoting
- 28 the program, and directs the treasurer to submit a report to
- 29 the governor and the general assembly regarding the program on
- 30 an annual basis.
