- 1 An Act providing for purse agreements for races of standardbred
- 2 horses at county fairs.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 99F.6, subsection 4, paragraph a, Code 2 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. (1) Before a license is granted, the division of
- 4 criminal investigation of the department of public safety
- 5 shall conduct a thorough background investigation of the
- 6 applicant for a license to operate a gambling game operation
- 7 on an excursion gambling boat. The applicant shall provide
- 8 information on a form as required by the division of criminal
- 9 investigation.
- 10 (2) A qualified sponsoring organization licensed to operate
- 11 gambling games under this chapter shall distribute the receipts
- 12 of all gambling games, less reasonable expenses, charges,
- 13 taxes, fees, and deductions allowed under this chapter, as
- 14 winnings to players or participants or shall distribute the
- 15 receipts for educational, civic, public, charitable, patriotic,
- 16 or religious uses as defined in section 99B.7, subsection 3,
- 17 paragraph "b". However, a licensee to conduct gambling games
- 18 under this chapter shall, unless an operating agreement for an
- 19 excursion gambling boat otherwise provides, distribute at least
- 20 three percent of the adjusted gross receipts for each license
- 21 year for educational, civic, public, charitable, patriotic,
- 22 or religious uses as defined in section 99B.7, subsection 3,
- 23 paragraph b. However, if a licensee who is also licensed to
- 24 conduct pari-mutuel wagering at a horse racetrack has unpaid
- 25 debt from the pari-mutuel racetrack operations, the first
- 26 receipts of the gambling games operated within the racetrack
- 27 enclosure less reasonable operating expenses, taxes, and fees
- 28 allowed under this chapter shall be first used to pay the
- 29 annual indebtedness.
- 30 (3) The commission shall authorize, subject to the debt
- 31 payments for horse racetracks and the provisions of paragraph
- 32 "b" for dog racetracks, a licensee who is also licensed to
- 33 conduct pari-mutuel dog or horse racing to use receipts from
- 34 gambling games within the racetrack enclosure to supplement
- 35 purses for races particularly for Iowa-bred horses pursuant to

- 1 an agreement which shall be negotiated between the licensee and
- 2 representatives of the dog or horse owners. For agreements
- 3 subject to commission approval concerning purses for horse
- 4 racing beginning on or after January 1, 2006, and ending
- 5 before January 1, 2021, the agreements shall provide that
- 6 total annual purses for all horse racing shall be no less than
- 7 eleven percent of the first two hundred million dollars of net
- 8 receipts, and six percent of net receipts above two hundred
- 9 million dollars. In addition, for agreements concerning horse
- 10 racing between the licensee operating the horse racetrack
- 11 in Polk county and representatives of standardbred horse
- 12 owners, the agreement shall include a supplemental amount
- 13 for standardbred horse races held at county fair racetracks
- 14 in the state, and the supplemental amount shall be included
- 15 in determining the total annual purses for all horse racing
- 16 that is required to be paid as provided by this paragraph
- 17 "a". Agreements that are subject to commission approval
- 18 concerning horse purses for a particular period of time
- 19 beginning on or after January 1, 2006, and ending before
- 20 January 1, 2021, shall be jointly submitted to the commission
- 21 for approval.
- 22 (4) A qualified sponsoring organization shall not make a
- 23 contribution to a candidate, political committee, candidate's
- 24 committee, state statutory political committee, county
- 25 statutory political committee, national political party, or
- 26 fund-raising event as these terms are defined in section
- 27 68A.102. The membership of the board of directors of a
- 28 qualified sponsoring organization shall represent a broad
- 29 interest of the communities.
- 30 (5) For purposes of this paragraph "a", "net receipts" means
- 31 the annual adjusted gross receipts from all gambling games less
- 32 the annual amount of money pledged by the owner of the facility
- 33 to fund a project approved to receive vision Iowa funds as of
- 34 July 1, 2004.

H.F. 2507

- 1 This bill concerns horse racing by providing for purse
- 2 agreements for races of standardbred horses at county fairs.
- Code section 99F.6 is amended to provide that agreements
- 4 concerning horse racing between the horse racetrack in Polk
- 5 county and representatives of standardbred horses shall include
- 6 a supplemental amount for standardbred races held at county
- 7 fairs which amount shall be included in determining the total
- 8 amount of horse purses that is required to be paid.
