Code section 29A.90 defines a "service member" as a member of the military forces of the state performing military service. The Code section further defines "military service" as referring to "full=time state military service" or "state active duty" as those terms are defined in Code section 29A.1 and applied to members of the Iowa national guard or Iowa air national guard. The bill expands the definition of "service member" to include a member of the organized reserves called to active duty from a reserve component status performing military service as defined in Code section 29A.90 and otherwise applicable to members of the Iowa national guard or Iowa air national guard.
