- 1 noninterstate highway by a livestock vehicle with five axles, a
- 2 minimum distance in feet between the centers of the first and
- 3 fifth axles of sixty-one feet, and a minimum distance between
- 4 the two rear axles of at least eight feet and one inch is
- 5 eighty-six thousand pounds.
- 6 EXPLANATION
- 7 This bill provides an exception to existing weight
- 8 restrictions for certain six and seven axle commercial motor
- 9 vehicles traveling on noninterstate highways. Currently, most
- 10 vehicles or combinations of vehicles are subject to a gross
- 11 weight limit of up to 80,000 pounds; however, the gross weight
- 12 limit for a livestock or construction vehicle with six or seven
- 13 axles ranges from 80,500 pounds to 90,000 pounds for six axles,
- 14 and up to 96,000 pounds for seven axles. The bill extends the
- 15 same weight limits that apply to livestock and construction
- 16 vehicles to all commercial vehicles of similar size.
- 17 The bill requires that a commercial motor vehicle traveling
- 18 under the relaxed weight restrictions must be operated by a
- 19 person with a commercial driver's license valid for the vehicle
- 20 operated, unless the operator is exempt from commercial driver
- 21 licensing requirements under existing law.
- 22 The provisions of the bill do not apply to vehicles operated
- 23 on interstate highways.
