1 2$ 2 2009, is amended to read as follows: 1 3 Employees shall not be required to be a resident of the 1 4 city in which they the employees are employed, but they shall 5 become a resident of the state at the time such appointment or 1 6 employment begins and shall remain a resident of the state 1 7 during employment. Cities However, cities may set a 1 8 reasonable maximum distances distance outside of the corporate 1 9 limits of the city, or a reasonable maximum travel time, that 1 10 police officers, fire fighters, and other critical municipal 1 11 employees may live from their place of employment. 1 12 EXPLANATION 1 13 Under current law, an employee under civil service is 1 14 required to be a resident of the state. This bill eliminates 1 15 the state residency requirement. Under current law, cities 1 16 may set reasonable maximum distances outside the corporate 1 17 limits of the city that police officers, fire fighters, and 1 18 other critical employees may live. The bill instead allows 1 19 cities to set a reasonable maximum distance outside of the 1 20 corporate limits of the city, or a reasonable maximum travel 1 21 time, that police officers, fire fighters, and other critical 1 22 employees may live from their place of employment. 1 23 LSB 1510HV 83 1 24 md/sc/5
