The commission shall limit the number of bobcats that may be taken each year in designated areas to a harvest of one thousand bobcats in 2009, two thousand bobcats in 2010, and to one bobcat per person for each year thereafter. A person hunting bobcats shall have a valid fur harvester license and be otherwise qualified to trap or hunt fur=bearing animals in the state. The commission shall, by rule, establish a season and the areas in the state where bobcats may be harvested but shall not establish a limit on the number of bobcats that may be harvested each year except as provided in this section. A person hunting bobcats must have a valid fur harvester license and be otherwise qualified to trap or hunt fur=bearing animals in the state. The commission is required to establish, by rule, a season and the areas in the state where bobcats may be harvested but is prohibited from establishing a limit on the number of bobcats that may be harvested each year except as provided in the bill for 2009 and 2010. Currently, administrative rules specify the counties where bobcats may be harvested, establish a season, provide a seasonal bag limit of one bobcat per person, and limit the number of bobcats that may be harvested to 200 bobcats per year.
