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         5. DISSOLUTION. The task force shall complete its duties
   2 no later than January 1, <del>2009</del> <u>2010</u>, but may complete its 3 duties and dissolve itself prior to that date.
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                                     EXPLANATION
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         This bill requires the governor to appoint the voting
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   6 members of the comprehensive recycling planning task force
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      from persons nominated by certain associations. Currently,
   8 the voting members are selected by various private entities.
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         The bill adds four new members to the task force.
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The task force was required to submit a written report to 11 the governor and the general assembly by January 1, 2009, and 12 was to be dissolved by January 1, 2009. The bill changes both 13 dates to January 1, 2010.
