| 13 | (1) A class "D" liquor control license may be issued to |

| 126 | This bill amends Code section 123.30 of the Iowa alcoholic |
| 127 | beverage control Act to provide that a watercraft is not a |
| 128 | passenger carrying boat or ship for hire that is eligible to |
| 129 | receive a class "D" liquor control license if the watercraft |
| 130 | is not an excursion gambling boat licensed under Code chapter |
| 131 | 99F, the sale of alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer is a primary |
| 132 | part of the ownership or operation of the watercraft, and the |
| 133 | transport of passengers for hire is only an incidental part of |
| 134 | that ownership or operation. |
