## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act exempting from the computation of the state individual
- 2 income tax certain amounts received from the veterans trust
- 3 fund and including a retroactive applicability provision.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 422.7, Code Supplement 2009, is amended
- 2 by adding the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 46A. Subtract, to the extent included,
- 4 amounts received from the veterans trust fund for any of the
- 5 following items:
- 6 a. Travel expenses pursuant to section 35A.13, subsection
- 7 7, paragraph "a".
- 8 b. Unemployment assistance pursuant to section 35A.13,
- 9 subsection 7, paragraph "c".
- 10 Sec. 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
- 11 retroactively to January 1, 2010, for tax years beginning on
- 12 or after that date.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- 14 The veterans trust fund allows moneys appropriated to
- 15 the veterans affairs commission to be expended for, among
- 16 other things, providing travel expenses for wounded veterans
- 17 and their spouses, if the expenses are directly related to
- 18 follow-up medical care, and unemployment assistance during a
- 19 period of unemployment, if the unemployment is due to prolonged
- 20 physical or mental illness or disability resulting from
- 21 military service.
- 22 This bill exempts these benefits from the individual income
- 23 tax.
- 24 The bill applies retroactively to January 1, 2010, for tax
- 25 years beginning on or after that date.
