A BILL FOR

1 An Act concerning authorized public employment by retired
2 judges.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 602.9110, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code
2 2009, is amended to read as follows:

3 However, this section does not prohibit the payment of an
4 annuity to a senior judge while serving as provided in section
5 602.9206 or to a retired judge while teaching no more than
6 six credit hours at an accredited educational institution
7 if permitted as a quasi-judicial or extrajudicial activity
8 pursuant to the Iowa code of judicial conduct, ch. 51, Iowa
9 court rules.

EXPLANATION

11 This bill provides that a retired judge may teach no
12 more than six credit hours per semester at an accredited
13 educational institution in this state if otherwise permitted
14 as a quasi-judicial activity authorized by the Iowa code of
15 judicial conduct and still receive the judge's retirement
16 annuity. Current law provides that no retirement annuity under
17 the judicial retirement system shall be paid to a nonsurvivor
18 annuitant if the person is employed in any other public
19 employment, except employment as a senior judge.
