## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the waiver of undergraduate tuition and
- 2 mandatory fees by state postsecondary institutions for
- 3 persons who served on active duty in the military service of
- 4 the United States in a designated combat zone or hazardous
- 5 duty area.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 260C.14, subsection 2, Code Supplement
- 2 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- Have authority to determine tuition rates for
- 4 instruction.
- 5 a. Tuition for residents of Iowa shall not exceed the
- 6 lowest tuition rate per semester, or the equivalent, charged
- 7 by an institution of higher education under the state board
- 8 of regents for a full-time resident student. However, except
- 9 for students enrolled under section 261E.6, if a local school
- 10 district pays tuition for a resident pupil of high school age,
- 11 the limitation on tuition for residents of Iowa shall not
- 12 apply, the amount of tuition shall be determined by the board
- 13 of directors of the community college with the consent of the
- 14 local school board, and the pupil shall not be included in the
- 15 full-time equivalent enrollment of the community college for
- 16 the purpose of computing general aid to the community college.
- 17 b. Tuition for nonresidents of Iowa shall not be less than
- 18 the marginal cost of instruction of a student attending the
- 19 college. A lower tuition for nonresidents may be permitted
- 20 under a reciprocal tuition agreement between a merged area and
- 21 an educational institution in another state, if the agreement
- 22 is approved by the director.
- c. The board may designate that a portion of the tuition
- 24 moneys collected from students be used for student aid
- 25 purposes.
- 26 d. The board shall waive tuition and mandatory fees for
- 27 persons who served on active duty in the military service of
- 28 the United States in a designated combat zone or hazardous duty
- 29 area on or after September 11, 2001.
- 30 Sec. 2. Section 262.9, Code Supplement 2009, is amended by
- 31 adding the following new subsection:
- 32 NEW SUBSECTION. 36. Waive tuition and mandatory fees for
- 33 persons who served on active duty in the military service of
- 34 the United States in a designated combat zone or hazardous duty
- 35 area on or after September 11, 2001, and who are enrolled as

- 1 undergraduate students.
- 2 Sec. 3. IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT. Section 25B.2, subsection
- 3 3, shall not apply to this Act.
- 4 EXPLANATION
- 5 This bill directs the boards of directors of the community
- 6 colleges and the state board of regents to waive undergraduate
- 7 tuition and mandatory fees for persons who served on active
- 8 duty in the military service of the United States in a
- 9 designated combat zone or hazardous duty area and who are
- 10 enrolled as undergraduate students.
- 11 The bill may include a state mandate as defined in Code
- 12 section 25B.3. The bill makes inapplicable Code section 25B.2,
- 13 subsection 3, which would relieve a political subdivision from
- 14 complying with a state mandate if funding for the cost of
- 15 the state mandate is not provided or specified. Therefore,
- 16 political subdivisions are required to comply with any state
- 17 mandate included in the bill.
