- 1 An Act relating to the renewal of the family planning network
- 2 waiver under the medical assistance program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. IOWA FAMILY PLANNING NETWORK WAIVER RENEWAL. The
- 2 department of human services shall amend the medical assistance
- 3 waiver for the Iowa family planning network to continue the
- 4 current waiver with the following modifications which provide
- 5 for all of the following:
- 6 l. Coverage for women who meet all of the following
- 7 criteria:
- 8 a. Are uninsured or have health insurance coverage that
- 9 does not include coverage for benefits provided under the Iowa
- 10 family planning network.
- 11 b. Have income of up to 300 percent of the federal poverty
- 12 level.
- 13 c. Are under 55 years of age.
- 2. Coverage of pregnancy prevention services for men who
- 15 meet the income, age, and insurance coverage specifications
- 16 described in subsection 1.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill directs the department of human services (DHS) to
- 19 renew the Iowa family planning network waiver due for renewal
- 20 in 2011, which currently provides family planning services
- 21 to women through 44 years of age, who have incomes up to 200
- 22 percent of the federal poverty level, and who do not have
- 23 private insurance unless they require confidential services or
- 24 are not already enrolled in the Medicaid program, IowaCare, or
- 25 hawk-i. The bill directs DHS to amend the waiver to continue
- 26 the current waiver with modifications that allow for coverage
- 27 for women through 54 years of age, with incomes up to 300
- 28 percent of the federal poverty level, and who are uninsured,
- 29 or if they are insured, have benefits that do not include
- 30 coverage for the benefits provided under the Iowa family
- 31 planning network. The amendment would also request coverage of
- 32 pregnancy prevention services for men who meet the same income,
- 33 age, and insurance coverage specifications as women.
