- 7 NEW SUBSECTION. 7. Permit any chiropractor licensed under
- 8 chapter 151 who is located in the geographic coverage area
- 9 served by the plan and who agrees to abide by the plan's terms,
- 10 conditions, reimbursement rates, and quality standards to serve
- ll as a participating provider in any plan offered to eligible
- 12 children under this chapter, including but not limited to a
- 13 limited provider network plan as defined in section 514C.13.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- 15 This bill provides that chiropractic services are a
- 16 benefit to be included in a qualified child health plan under
- 17 the hawk-i program. Additionally, the bill directs that
- 18 participating insurers are to permit a licensed chiropractor
- 19 located in the geographic coverage area served by the insurer's
- 20 plan who agrees to abide by the plan's terms, conditions,
- 21 reimbursement rates, and quality standards to serve as
- 22 a participating provider in any plan offered to eligible
- 23 children, including a limited provider network plan.
