- 1 An Act appropriating funds to award grants to Iowa community
- 2 colleges in order to implement recommendations from the
- governor's green jobs task force and reach underserved
- 4 populations.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT GRANTS —
- 2 IMPLEMENTATION OF GREEN JOBS TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATIONS. There
- 3 is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
- 4 department of workforce development for the fiscal year
- 5 beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011, the following
- 6 amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the
- 7 purposes designated:
- 8 For allocation to the workforce development board to
- 9 award grants to Iowa community colleges to implement the
- 10 recommendations of the green jobs task force, established
- 11 by executive order number 16, with fifty percent of the
- 12 grants being used to provide outreach programs to underserved
- 13 populations:
- 14 \$ 1,000,000
- 15 For purposes of this section, "underserved populations"
- 16 means persons making less than twenty thousand dollars a year,
- 17 minorities, persons with disabilities, the elderly, and persons
- 18 convicted of a felony who are attempting to reenter society
- 19 after release from incarceration.
- 20 EXPLANATION
- 21 This bill appropriates \$1 million to the department of
- 22 workforce development for FY 2010-2011. The funds are to be
- 23 allocated to the workforce development board for grants to
- 24 Iowa community colleges to implement the recommendations of
- 25 the green jobs task force, which was established by Executive
- 26 Order Number 16. Fifty percent of the grants shall be used to
- 27 provide outreach programs to underserved populations.
