A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act requiring certain health benefit contracts, policies, or
- 2 plans to provide coverage of tobacco use cessation programs
- 3 and providing an applicability date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **514C.26 Tobacco use cessation** 2 program coverage.
- 3 1. Notwithstanding the uniformity of treatment requirements
- 4 of section 514C.6, a contract, policy, or plan providing for
- 5 third-party payment or prepayment of health or medical expenses
- 6 shall provide coverage benefits for a tobacco use cessation
- 7 program for any enrollee who is eighteen years of age or
- 8 older, including but not limited to the following classes of
- 9 third-party payment provider contracts, policies, or plans
- 10 delivered, issued for delivery, continued, or renewed in this
- 11 state on or after September 1, 2010:
- 12 a. Individual or group accident and sickness insurance
- 13 providing coverage on an expense-incurred basis.
- 14 b. An individual or group hospital or medical service
- 15 contract issued pursuant to chapter 509, 514, or 514A.
- 16 c. An individual or group health maintenance organization
- 17 contract regulated under chapter 514B.
- 18 d. An individual or group Medicare supplemental policy,
- 19 unless coverage pursuant to such policy is preempted by federal
- 20 law.
- 21 e. A plan established pursuant to chapter 509A for public
- 22 employees.
- 23 2. This section shall not apply to accident-only, specified
- 24 disease, short-term hospital or medical, hospital confinement
- 25 indemnity, credit, dental, vision, long-term care, basic
- 26 hospital and medical-surgical expense coverage as defined
- 27 by the commissioner, disability income insurance coverage,
- 28 coverage issued as a supplement to liability insurance,
- 29 workers' compensation or similar insurance, or automobile
- 30 medical payment insurance.
- 31 3. As used in this section, "tobacco use cessation program"
- 32 means a program recommended by a physician that follows the
- 33 United States public health service guidelines for tobacco use
- 34 cessation or a product or service with an "A" or "B" rating
- 35 from the task force on community preventive services at the

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- 1 United States centers for disease control and prevention of the
- 2 United States department of health and human services. "Tobacco
- 3 use cessation program" includes education and medical treatment
- 4 components designed to assist a person in ceasing the use of
- 5 tobacco products.
- 6 4. The commissioner of insurance shall adopt rules pursuant
- 7 to chapter 17A as necessary to administer this section.
- 8 EXPLANATION
- 9 This bill requires that specified individual or group
- 10 health benefit contracts, policies, or plans provide coverage
- 11 benefits for a tobacco use cessation program for any enrollee
- 12 who is 18 years of age or older. The bill is applicable to
- 13 third-party payment provider contracts, policies, or plans that
- 14 are delivered, issued for delivery, continued, or renewed in
- 15 this state on or after September 1, 2010.
- 16 For purposes of the bill, "tobacco use cessation program"
- 17 means a program recommended by a physician that follows the
- 18 United States public health service guidelines for tobacco use
- 19 cessation or a product or service with an "A" or "B" rating
- 20 from the task force on community preventive services at the
- 21 United States centers for disease control and prevention.
