A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to beautification grants to be awarded from the
- 2 solid waste account of the groundwater protection fund.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 455E.11, subsection 2, paragraph a,
- 2 subparagraph (1), Code Supplement 2009, is amended by adding
- 3 the following new subparagraph division:
- 4 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH DIVISION. (Oa) (i) Each fiscal year for
- 5 the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 30,
- 6 2014, not more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars to the
- 7 department for purposes of awarding a beautification grant each
- 8 year to one organization that does all of the following:
- 9 (A) Assists communities and organizations in cleanup and
- 10 beautification projects.
- 11 (B) Conducts research to assist in the understanding of
- 12 reasons for littering and illegal dumping.
- 13 (C) Administers antilittering and beautification education 14 programs.
- 15 (D) Increases public awareness of the costs of littering.
- 16 (ii) The grant recipient shall do all of the following:
- 17 (A) Expend not more than twenty-five percent of the moneys
- 18 for a public education and awareness initiative designed to
- 19 reduce litter and illegal dumping.
- 20 (B) Expend not more than twenty-five percent of the moneys
- 21 for all of the following:
- 22 (I) An educational initiative designed to discourage
- 23 littering and illegal dumping for persons attending school in
- 24 kindergarten through grade twelve.
- 25 (II) A litter-free schools initiative.
- 26 (III) A neighborhood beautification initiative.
- 27 (C) Expend not more than twenty-five percent of the moneys
- 28 for an illegal dumping surveillance program.
- 29 (D) Expend not more than twenty-five percent of the moneys
- 30 for a community partnership program designed to support
- 31 community beautification projects.
- 32 (iii) As a condition of the grant award each year, the
- 33 department shall require the grant recipient to submit a
- 34 written report to the department by the end of the fiscal year
- 35 for which the grant is awarded. In addition to any other

- 1 information required by the department, the report shall
- 2 include information detailing the expenditure of all moneys
- 3 received by the organization and the results achieved through
- 4 the expenditure of the money.
- 5 EXPLANATION
- 6 This bill relates to beautification grants.
- 7 The bill, for the fiscal period beginning July 1, 2010,
- 8 and ending June 30, 2014, annually allocates \$250,000 from
- 9 the solid waste account of the groundwater protection fund
- 10 to the department of natural resources for purposes of a
- 11 beautification grant to be awarded to one organization.
- 12 The bill provides criteria for determining the grant
- 13 recipient.
- 14 The bill requires the grant recipient to use grant moneys
- 15 for a public education and awareness initiative designed to
- 16 reduce litter and illegal dumping, an educational initiative
- 17 designed to discourage littering and illegal dumping for
- 18 persons attending school in kindergarten through grade 12, a
- 19 litter-free schools initiative, a neighborhood beautification
- 20 initiative, an illegal dumping surveillance program, and a
- 21 community partnership program designed to support community
- 22 beautification projects.
- 23 The bill includes a reporting requirement for grant
- 24 recipients.
