A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act exempting certain entities from being required to
- 2 solemnize, celebrate, or promote a marriage.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 595.21 Exemptions solemnization
- 2 or celebration of a marriage promotion of marriage.
- A religious organization, an individual who is
- 4 managed, directed, or supervised by or in conjunction with a
- 5 religious organization, or a nonprofit organization operated,
- 6 supervised, or controlled by or in conjunction with a religious
- 7 organization, shall not be required to provide services,
- 8 accommodations, advantages, facilities, goods, or privileges to
- 9 an individual if the request for such services, accommodations,
- 10 advantages, facilities, goods, or privileges is related to the
- 11 solemnization of a marriage, the celebration of a marriage,
- 12 or the promotion of marriage through religious counseling,
- 13 programs, courses, retreats, or housing designated for married
- 14 individuals, and such solemnization, celebration, or promotion
- 15 of marriage would cause the organization to violate the
- 16 sincerely held religious beliefs to which the organization
- 17 subscribes or the individual to violate the individual's
- 18 sincerely held religious beliefs.
- Refusal to provide services, accommodations, advantages,
- 20 facilities, goods, or privileges in accordance with this
- 21 section shall not result in either of the following:
- 22 a. Creation of a civil claim or cause of action.
- 23 b. An action by the state to penalize or withhold benefits
- 24 from such religious organization; from an individual who is
- 25 managed, directed, or supervised by or in conjunction with
- 26 such religious organization; or from a nonprofit organization
- 27 operated, supervised, or controlled by or in conjunction with
- 28 such religious organization.
- 29 EXPLANATION
- 30 This bill provides an exemption for religious organizations;
- 31 individuals who are managed, directed, or supervised by or
- 32 in conjunction with a religious organization; and nonprofit
- 33 organizations operated, supervised, or controlled by or in
- 34 conjunction with a religious organization, from a requirement
- 35 to provide services, accommodations, advantages, facilities,

- 1 goods, or privileges to an individual if the request for such 2 services, accommodations, advantages, facilities, goods, or
- 3 privileges is related to the solemnization of a marriage, the
- 4 celebration of a marriage, or the promotion of marriage through
- 5 religious counseling, programs, courses, retreats, or housing
- 6 designated for married individuals, and such solemnization,
- 7 celebration, or promotion of marriage would cause the religious
- 8 or nonprofit organization to violate the sincerely held
- 9 religious beliefs to which the organization subscribes or
- 10 the individual associated with the religious organization to
- 11 violate the individual's sincerely held religious beliefs.
- 12 The bill also provides that refusal to provide services,
- 13 accommodations, advantages, facilities, goods, or privileges in
- 14 accordance with the bill shall not result in the creation of
- 15 a civil claim or cause of action or an action by the state to
- 16 penalize or withhold benefits from such religious organization,
- 17 individual, or nonprofit organization.
