- l An Act providing for the issuance and display of one motor
- 2 vehicle registration plate.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 8A.362, subsection 8, Code Supplement 2 2009, is amended to read as follows:

The director shall require that a sign be placed on 3 8. 4 each state-owned motor vehicle in a conspicuous place which 5 indicates its ownership by the state. This requirement 6 shall not apply to motor vehicles requested to be exempt by 7 the director or by the commissioner of public safety. All 8 state-owned motor vehicles shall display a registration 9 plates plate bearing the word "official" except motor vehicles 10 requested to be furnished with an ordinary plates plate by the 11 director or by the commissioner of public safety pursuant to 12 section 321.19. The director shall keep an accurate record of 13 the registration plates used on all state-owned motor vehicles. Sec. 2. Section 321.18, subsection 7, Code Supplement 2009, 14 15 is amended to read as follows:

16 7. Any school bus in this state used exclusively for 17 the transportation of pupils to and from school or a school 18 function or for the purposes provided in section 285.1, 19 subsection 1, and section 285.10, subsection 9, or used 20 exclusively for the transportation of children enrolled in a 21 federal head start program. Upon application the department 22 shall, without charge, issue a registration certificate and 23 registration plates <u>plate</u>. The <u>plates</u> <u>plate</u> shall be attached 24 to the <u>front and</u> rear of each bus exempt from registration 25 under this subsection.

26 Sec. 3. Section 321.19, subsection 1, Code 2009, is amended 27 to read as follows:

1. <u>a.</u> All vehicles owned or leased for a period of sixty days or more by the government and used in the transaction of official business by the representatives of foreign governments or by officers, boards, or departments of the government of the United States, and by the state, counties, municipalities and other political subdivisions of the state including vehicles used by an urban transit company operated by a municipality or a regional transit system, and self-propelling vehicles used

1 neither for the conveyance of persons for hire, pleasure, or 2 business nor for the transportation of freight other than those 3 used by an urban transit company operated by a municipality or 4 a regional transit system, all fire trucks, providing they are 5 not owned and operated for a pecuniary profit, and authorized 6 emergency vehicles used only in disaster relief owned and 7 operated by an organization not operated for pecuniary profit, 8 are exempted from the payment of the registration fees imposed 9 by this chapter, except as provided for urban transit companies 10 in subsection 2, but are not exempt from the penalties provided 11 in this chapter.

12 b. The department shall furnish, on application, free of 13 charge, distinguishing plates for vehicles thus exempted, 14 which plates except plates on state patrol vehicles shall bear 15 the word "official" and the department shall keep a separate 16 record. Registration plates issued for state patrol vehicles, 17 except unmarked patrol vehicles, shall bear two red stars 18 on a yellow background, one before and one following the 19 registration number on the plate, which registration number 20 shall be the officer's badge number. Registration plates 21 issued for county sheriff's patrol vehicles shall display 22 one seven-pointed gold star followed by the letter "S" and 23 the call number of the vehicle. However, the director of 24 the department of administrative services or the director of 25 transportation may order the issuance of a regular registration 26 plates plate for any exempted vehicle used by peace officers 27 in the enforcement of the law, persons enforcing chapter 124 28 and other laws relating to controlled substances, persons in 29 the department of justice, the alcoholic beverages division 30 of the department of commerce, disease investigators of the 31 Iowa department of public health, the department of inspections 32 and appeals, and the department of revenue, who are regularly 33 assigned to conduct investigations which cannot reasonably 34 be conducted with a vehicle displaying an "official" state 35 registration plates plate, persons in the Iowa lottery

1 authority whose regularly assigned duties relating to security 2 or the carrying of lottery tickets cannot reasonably be 3 conducted with a vehicle displaying an "official" registration 4 plates plate, persons in the department of economic development 5 who are regularly assigned duties relating to existing 6 industry expansion or business attraction, and mental health 7 professionals or health care professionals who provide off-site 8 or in-home medical or mental health services to clients of 9 publicly funded programs. For purposes of sale of exempted 10 vehicles, the exempted governmental body, upon the sale of 11 the exempted vehicle, may issue for in-transit purposes a 12 pasteboard card bearing the words "Vehicle in Transit", the 13 name of the official body from which the vehicle was purchased, 14 together with the date of the purchase plainly marked in at 15 least one-inch letters, and other information required by the 16 department. The in-transit card is valid for use only within 17 forty-eight hours after the purchase date as indicated on the 18 bill of sale which shall be carried by the driver. 19 Sec. 4. Section 321.20B, subsection 4, paragraph a,

20 subparagraph (3), unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2009, is amended 21 to read as follows:

Issue a citation and remove the motor vehicle's license plates plate and registration receipt.

Sec. 5. Section 321.20B, subsection 4, paragraph a, subparagraph (3), subparagraph division (a), Code 2009, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Upon removing the license plates plate and registration
receipt, the peace officer shall deliver the plates plate for
destruction, as appropriate, and forward the registration
receipt and evidence of the violation, as determined by the
department, to the county treasurer of the county in which the
motor vehicle is registered.

33 Sec. 6. Section 321.20B, subsection 4, paragraph a, 34 subparagraph (4), subparagraph division (a), Code 2009, is 35 amended to read as follows:

1 (a) Issue a citation, remove the motor vehicle's license 2 <u>plates plate</u> and registration receipt, and impound the motor 3 vehicle. The peace officer shall deliver the <u>plates plate</u> for 4 destruction, as appropriate, and forward the registration 5 receipt and evidence of the violation, as determined by the 6 department, to the county treasurer of the county in which the 7 motor vehicle is registered.

8 Sec. 7. Section 321.20B, subsection 4, paragraph b, 9 subparagraph (1), subparagraph divisions (a) and (b), Code 10 2009, are amended to read as follows:

11 (a) If the person was cited pursuant to paragraph "a", 12 subparagraph (3), the owner or driver shall provide a copy of 13 the receipt to the county treasurer of the county in which the 14 motor vehicle is registered and the owner shall be assessed a 15 fifteen dollar administrative fee by the county treasurer who 16 shall issue <u>a</u> new license <u>plates</u> <u>plate</u> and registration to the 17 person after payment of the fee.

(b) If the person was cited pursuant to paragraph "a",
subparagraph (4), the owner or driver, after the owner
provides proof of financial liability coverage to the clerk
of court, may claim the motor vehicle after such person pays
any applicable fine and the costs of towing and storage for
the motor vehicle, and the owner or driver provides a copy
of the receipt and the owner pays to the county treasurer of
the county in which the motor vehicle is registered a fifteen
dollar administrative fee, and the county treasurer shall issue
<u>a</u> new license <u>plates</u> <u>plate</u> and registration to the person.
Sec. 8. Section 321.20B, subsection 4, paragraph b,
subparagraph (2), subparagraph divisions (a) and (b), Code

30 2009, are amended to read as follows:

31 (a) Sign an admission of violation on the citation and 32 remit to the clerk of court a scheduled fine as provided in 33 section 805.8A, subsection 14, paragraph "f", for a violation of 34 subsection 1. Upon payment of the fine to the clerk of court of 35 the county where the citation was issued, payment of a fifteen

1 dollar administrative fee to the county treasurer of the 2 county in which the motor vehicle is registered, and providing 3 proof of payment of any applicable fine and proof of financial 4 liability coverages to the county treasurer of the county in 5 which the motor vehicle is registered, the treasurer shall 6 issue a new license plates plate and registration to the owner. (b) Request an appearance before the court on the matter. 7 8 If the matter goes before the court, and the owner or driver 9 is found guilty of a violation of subsection 1, the court 10 may impose a fine as provided in section 805.8A, subsection 11 14, paragraph "f'', for a violation of subsection 1, or the 12 court may order the person to perform unpaid community service 13 instead of the fine. Upon the payment of the fine or the 14 entry of the order for unpaid community service, the person 15 shall provide proof of payment or entry of such order and the 16 county treasurer of the county in which the motor vehicle 17 is registered shall issue a new license plates plate and 18 registration to the owner upon the owner providing proof of 19 financial liability coverage and paying a fifteen dollar 20 administrative fee to the county treasurer.

21 Sec. 9. Section 321.22, subsection 1, Code Supplement 2009, 22 is amended to read as follows:

1. An urban transit company or system having a franchise to operate in any city and any regional transit system may make application to the department, upon forms furnished by the department, for a certificate containing a distinguishing number and for one or more pairs of registration plates to be attached to the front and rear of buses owned or operated by the transit company or system.

30 Sec. 10. Section 321.23, subsection 3, Code Supplement 31 2009, is amended to read as follows:

32 3. In the event an applicant for registration of a foreign 33 vehicle for which a certificate of title has been issued is 34 able to furnish evidence of being the registered owner of the 35 vehicle to the county treasurer of the owner's residence,

1 although unable to surrender such certificate of title, 2 the county treasurer may issue a registration receipt and 3 plates plate upon receipt of the required annual registration 4 fee and the fee for new registration but shall not issue a 5 certificate of title thereto for the vehicle. Upon surrender 6 of the certificate of title from the foreign state, the 7 county treasurer shall issue a certificate of title to the 8 owner, of the vehicle or other person entitled thereto, 9 of such vehicle to the certificate of title as provided in 10 this chapter. The owner of a vehicle registered under this 11 subsection shall not be required to obtain a certificate of 12 title in this state and may transfer ownership of the vehicle 13 to a motor vehicle dealer licensed under chapter 322 if, at the 14 time of the transfer, the certificate of title is held by a 15 secured party and the dealer has forwarded to the secured party 16 the sum necessary to discharge the security interest pursuant 17 to section 321.48, subsection 1.

18 Sec. 11. Section 321.25, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2009, 19 is amended to read as follows:

20 A vehicle may be operated upon the highways of this state 21 without a registration plates plate for a period of forty-five 22 days after the date of delivery of the vehicle to the purchaser 23 from a dealer if a card bearing the words "registration applied 24 for" is attached on the rear of the vehicle. The card shall 25 have plainly stamped or stenciled the registration number of 26 the dealer from whom the vehicle was purchased and the date 27 of delivery of the vehicle. In addition, a dealer licensed 28 to sell new motor vehicles may attach the card to a new motor 29 vehicle delivered by the dealer to the purchaser even if the 30 vehicle was purchased from an out-of-state dealer and the card 31 shall bear the registration number of the dealer that delivered 32 the vehicle. A dealer shall not issue a card to a person 33 known to the dealer to be in possession of a registration 34 plates plate which may be attached to the vehicle. A dealer 35 shall not issue a card unless an application for registration

1 and certificate of title has been made by the purchaser and a 2 receipt issued to the purchaser of the vehicle showing the fee 3 paid by the person making the application. Dealers' records 4 shall indicate the agency to which the fee is sent and the date 5 the fee is sent. The dealer shall forward the application by 6 the purchaser to the county treasurer or state office within 7 thirty calendar days from the date of delivery of the vehicle. 8 However, if the vehicle is subject to a security interest 9 and has been offered for sale pursuant to section 321.48, 10 subsection 1, the dealer shall forward the application by the 11 purchaser to the county treasurer or state office within thirty 12 calendar days from the date of the delivery of the vehicle to 13 the purchaser.

14 Sec. 12. Section 321.26, subsection 2, Code 2009, is amended 15 to read as follows:

16 The county treasurer may adjust the renewal or expiration 2. 17 date of vehicles when deemed necessary to equalize the number 18 of vehicles registered in each twelve-month period or for 19 the administrative efficiency of the county treasurer's The adjustment shall be accomplished by delivery 20 office. 21 of a written notice to the vehicle owner of the adjustment 22 and allowance of a credit for the remaining months of the 23 unused portion of the annual registration fee, rounded to the 24 nearest whole dollar, which amount shall be deducted from 25 the annual registration fee due at the time of registration. 26 Upon receipt of the notification the owner shall, within 27 thirty days, surrender the registration card and registration 28 plates plate to the county treasurer of the county where 29 the vehicle is registered, except that the registration 30 plates plate shall not be surrendered if validation stickers 31 or other emblems are used to designate the month and year 32 of expiration of registration. Upon payment of the annual 33 registration fee, less the credit allowed for the remaining 34 months of the unused portion of the annual registration fee, 35 the county treasurer shall issue a new registration card and

4 Sec. 13. Section 321.34, Code 2009, is amended to read as 5 follows:

6 321.34 Plates Plate or validation sticker furnished — 7 retained by owner — special plates.

1. *Plates Plate issued.* The county treasurer upon receiving 8 9 application, accompanied by proper fee, for registration of a 10 vehicle shall issue to the owner one registration plate for 11 a motorcycle, motorized bicycle, truck tractor, trailer, or 12 semitrailer and two registration plates for every other motor 13 vehicle. The registration plates plate, including a special 14 registration plates plate, shall be assigned to the owner of a 15 vehicle. When the owner of a registered vehicle transfers or 16 assigns ownership of the vehicle to another person, the owner 17 shall remove the registration plates plate from the vehicle. 18 The owner shall forward the plates plate to the county 19 treasurer where the vehicle is registered or the owner may have 20 the plates plate assigned to another vehicle within thirty days 21 after transfer, upon payment of the fees required by law. The 22 owner shall immediately affix a registration plates 23 plate retained by the owner to another vehicle owned or 24 acquired by the owner, providing the owner complies with 25 section 321.46. The department shall adopt rules providing for 26 the assignment of a registration plates plate to the transferee 27 of a vehicle for which a credit is allowed under section 28 321.46, subsection 6.

29 2. Validation stickers.

30 <u>a.</u> In lieu of issuing <u>a</u> new registration plates 31 <u>plate</u> each registration year for a vehicle renewing 32 registration, the department may reassign the registration 33 plates <u>plate</u> previously issued to the vehicle and may adopt 34 and prescribe an annual validation sticker indicating payment 35 of annual registration fees. The department shall issue one

1 validation sticker for each set of registration plates. The 2 sticker shall specify the month and year of expiration of the 3 registration plates plate. The sticker shall be displayed 4 only on the rear registration plate, except that the sticker 5 shall be displayed on the front registration plate of a truck 6 tractor.

7 <u>b.</u> The state department of transportation shall adopt rules
8 to provide for the placement of the motor vehicle registration
9 validation sticker.

3. Radio operators plates plate. The owner of an 10 ll automobile, motorcycle, trailer, or motor truck who holds an 12 amateur radio license issued by the federal communications 13 commission may, upon written application to the county 14 treasurer accompanied by a fee of five dollars, order 15 a special registration plates plate bearing the call letters 16 authorized the radio station covered by the person's amateur 17 radio license. When received by the county treasurer, 18 such the special registration plates plate shall be 19 issued to the applicant in exchange for the registration 20 plates plate previously issued to the person. Not more than 21 one set of special registration plates plate may be issued to 22 an applicant. Said The fee shall be in addition to and not 23 in lieu of the fee for a regular registration plates plate. 24 Special A special registration plates plate must be surrendered 25 upon expiration of the owner's amateur radio license and 26 the owner shall thereupon then be entitled to the owner's 27 regular registration plates plate. The county treasurer shall 28 validate a special plates plate in the same manner as a regular 29 registration plates plate, upon payment of five dollars in 30 addition to the regular annual registration fee.

31 4. Multiyear plates plate. In lieu of issuing <u>an</u> annual 32 registration plates <u>plate</u> for trailers, semitrailers, motor 33 trucks, and truck tractors, the department may issue a 34 multiyear registration plate for a three-year period or a 35 permanent registration plate for trailers and semitrailers

1 licensed under chapter 326, and a permanent registration
2 plate for motor trucks and truck tractors licensed under
3 chapter 326, upon payment of the appropriate registration fee.
4 Payment of fees for trailers and semitrailers for a permanent
5 registration plate shall, at the option of the registrant,
6 be made at five-year intervals or on an annual basis. Fees
7 from three-year and five-year payments shall not be reduced or
8 prorated. Payment of fees for motor trucks and truck tractors
9 shall be made on an annual basis.

10 5. Personalized registration plates plate.

Upon application and the payment of a fee of twenty-five 11 a. 12 dollars, the director may issue to the owner of a motor 13 vehicle registered in this state or a trailer or travel 14 trailer registered in this state, a personalized registration 15 plates plate marked with up to seven initials, letters, 16 or combination of numerals and letters requested by the 17 owner. However, a personalized registration plates plate for 18 motorcycles and motorized bicycles shall be marked with no 19 more than six initials, letters, or combinations of numerals 20 and letters. Upon receipt of the personalized registration 21 plates plate, the applicant shall surrender the regular 22 registration plates plate to the county treasurer. The fee for 23 issuance of the personalized registration plates plate shall be 24 in addition to the regular annual registration fee.

b. The county treasurer shall validate <u>a</u> personalized registration <u>plates plate</u> in the same manner as <u>a</u> regular registration <u>plates are plate is</u> validated under this section at an annual fee of five dollars in addition to the regular annual registration fee. A person renewing a personalized registration plate within one month following the time requirements under section 321.40 may renew the personalized plate without paying the additional registration fee under paragraph "a" but shall pay the five-dollar fee in addition to the regular annual registration fee and any penalties subject to regular registration plate holders for late renewal.

c. The fees collected by the director under this subsection
 2 shall be paid to the treasurer of state and credited by the
 3 treasurer of state as provided in section 321.145.

6. Sample vehicle registration plates plate. Vehicle A
vehicle registration plates plate displaying the general design
of a regular registration plates plate, with the word "sample"
displayed on the plate, may be furnished to any person upon
payment of a fee of three dollars, except that such plates may
be furnished to governmental agencies without cost. Sample A
sample registration plates plate shall not be attached to a
vehicle moved on the highways of this state.

12 7. Collegiate plates plate.

13 a. Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the 14 director may issue to the owner of a motor vehicle subject 15 to registration under section 321.109, subsection 1, motor 16 truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, trailer over two 17 thousand pounds, or travel trailer registered in this state, 18 <u>a</u> collegiate registration <u>plates</u> <u>plate</u> created pursuant to 19 this subsection. Upon receipt of the collegiate registration 20 <u>plates</u> <u>plate</u>, the applicant shall surrender the regular 21 registration <u>plates</u> plate to the county treasurer.

b. Collegiate <u>A collegiate</u> registration <u>plates</u> <u>plate</u> shall be designed for each of the three state universities. The collegiate registration plates shall be designated as follows: (1) The letters "ISU" followed by a four-digit number all in cardinal on a gold background for Iowa state university of science and technology.

(2) The letters "UNI" followed by a four-digit number all
in purple on a gold background for the university of northern
30 Iowa.

31 (3) The letters "UI" followed by a four-digit number all in 32 black on a gold background for the state university of Iowa. 33 (4) In lieu of the letter-number designation provided under 34 subparagraphs (1) through (3), the collegiate registration 35 plates may be designated in the manner provided for

1 personalized registration plates under subsection 5, paragraph

2 "a", in the colors designated for the respective universities 3 under subparagraphs (1) through (3).

4 c. (1) The fees for a collegiate registration plate are as 5 follows:

(a) A registration fee of twenty-five dollars.

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7 (b) A special collegiate registration fee of twenty-five 8 dollars.

9 (2) These fees are in addition to the regular annual 10 registration fee. The fees collected by the director under 11 this subsection shall be paid monthly to the treasurer of 12 state and deposited in the road use tax fund. The treasurer 13 of state shall credit monthly from the statutory allocations 14 fund created under section 321.145, subsection 2, to Iowa 15 state university of science and technology, the university of 16 northern Iowa, and the state university of Iowa respectively, 17 the amount of the special collegiate registration fees 18 collected in the previous month for collegiate registration 19 plates designed for the university. The moneys credited are 20 appropriated to the respective universities to be used for 21 scholarships for students attending the universities.

d. The county treasurer shall validate <u>a</u> collegiate
registration <u>plates plate</u> in the same manner as <u>a</u> regular
registration <u>plates are plate is</u> validated under this section
at an annual fee of five dollars in addition to the regular
annual registration fee.

e. A collegiate registration plate shall not be issued if its combination of alphanumeric characters are identical to those contained on a current personalized registration plate issued under subsection 5. However, the owner of a motor vehicle who has a personalized registration plate issued for the motor vehicle may, after proper application and payment of fees, be issued a collegiate registration plate containing the same alphanumeric characters as those on the personalized plate. Upon receipt of the collegiate

1 registration plates plate, the owner shall surrender the
2 personalized registration plates plate to the county treasurer.
3 7A. Collegiate plates — Private four-year colleges and
4 universities.

5 *a.* Upon application by a private four-year college or 6 university located in this state and payment of the initial 7 set-up costs for establishing the collegiate plate, the 8 department, in consultation with the college or university, may 9 design a special collegiate registration plate displaying the 10 colors associated with the college or university.

Upon application and payment of the proper fees, the 11 b. 12 director may issue to the owner of a motor vehicle subject 13 to registration under section 321.109, subsection 1, motor 14 truck, motor home, multipurpose vehicle, trailer over two 15 thousand pounds, or travel trailer registered in this state, 16 a collegiate registration plates plate created pursuant to The fee for the issuance of a collegiate 17 this subsection. 18 registration plates plate is twenty-five dollars, which fee 19 is in addition to the regular annual registration fee for the 20 vehicle. An applicant may obtain a personalized collegiate 21 registration plate upon payment of the additional fee for a 22 personalized plate as provided in subsection 5 in addition to 23 the collegiate plate fee and the regular registration fee. 24 The county treasurer shall validate a collegiate registration 25 plates plate issued under this subsection in the same manner 26 as a regular registration plates plate, upon payment of five 27 dollars in addition to the regular annual registration fee. 28 Upon receipt of the collegiate registration plates plate, 29 the applicant shall surrender the regular registration 30 plates plate to the county treasurer.

31 c. A personalized collegiate registration plate shall 32 not be issued if its combination of alphanumeric characters 33 are identical to those contained on a current personalized 34 registration plate issued under subsection 5. However, the 35 owner of a motor vehicle who has a personalized registration

1 plate issued for the motor vehicle may, after proper 2 application and payment of fees, be issued a collegiate 3 registration plate containing the same alphanumeric characters 4 as those on the personalized plate. Upon receipt of the 5 collegiate registration plates plate, the owner shall surrender 6 the personalized registration plates plate to the county 7 treasurer.

8 8. Medal of honor plates plate.

a. The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration 9 10 under section 321.109, subsection 1, motorcycle, trailer, 11 or motor truck who has been awarded the medal of honor may, 12 upon written application to the department, order a special 13 registration plates plate which shall be red, white, and blue 14 in color and shall bear an emblem of the medal of honor and 15 an identifying number. Each applicant applying for a special 16 registration plates plate under this subsection may order only 17 one set of registration plates plate under this subsection. 18 The application is subject to approval by the department and 19 the special registration plates plate shall be issued at no 20 charge to the applicant in exchange for the registration 21 plates plate previously issued to the person. A person who 22 is issued a special plates plate under this subsection is 23 exempt from payment of any annual registration fee for the 24 motor vehicle bearing the special plates plate. The department 25 shall validate the special plates plate in the same manner as 26 a regular registration plates are plate is validated under this 27 section. The department shall not issue a special registration 28 plates plate until service organizations in the state have 29 furnished the department either the special dies or the cost of 30 the special dies necessary for the manufacture of the special 31 registration plate.

32 <u>b.</u> The surviving spouse of a person who was issued <u>a</u> special 33 plates <u>plate</u> under this subsection may continue to use the 34 special plates <u>plate</u> subject to registration of the special 35 plates plate in the surviving spouse's name. If the surviving

8A. Ex-prisoner of war special plates plate.

5 The owner of a motor vehicle subject to registration a. 6 under section 321.109, subsection 1, motorcycle, trailer, or 7 motor truck who was a prisoner of war during a time of military 8 conflict may, upon written application to the department, 9 order only one set of special registration plates plate with 10 an ex-prisoner of war processed emblem. 3 The transition from the use of motor vehicle registration 4 plates on both the front and rear of certain vehicles to the 5 use of such plates on only the rear of certain vehicles, as 6 directed by this Act, shall be accomplished in stages. A 7 person applying for a new or replacement registration plate 8 on or after July 1, 2010, shall receive only one registration 9 plate. Otherwise, the transition shall not be accomplished 10 until a new series of registration plates is issued to replace 11 a current series. The department of transportation shall adopt 12 rules to implement the transition.

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EXPLANATION

14 This bill amends Code section 321.37, relating to the 15 display of motor vehicle registration plates, to provide 16 that only one registration plate shall be issued for a motor 17 vehicle. The registration plate is to be attached to the rear 18 of the motor vehicle, except that the registration plate for 19 a truck tractor is to be attached to the front of the truck 20 tractor. Currently, two registration plates are issued for 21 a motor vehicle other than a motorcycle, motorized bicycle, 22 or truck tractor, to be attached to the front and rear of the 23 vehicle.

The bill also makes numerous corresponding Code language changes, makes some Code language changes to enhance readability, and provides for the transition from the use of two registration plates to the use of one registration plate.
