- 1 Section 1. Section 558A.4, subsection 1, Code 2009, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. The disclosure statement shall include information
- 4 relating to the condition and important characteristics
- 5 of the property and structures located on the property,
- 6 including significant defects in the structural integrity of
- 7 the structure, as provided in rules which shall be adopted
- 8 by the real estate commission pursuant to section 543B.9.
- 9 The rules may require the disclosure to include information
- 10 relating to the property's zoning classification; the
- 11 condition of plumbing, heating, or electrical systems; or the
- 12 presence of pests. The rules shall require the disclosure
- 13 to include information relating to the previous manufacture
- 14 of amphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of isomers, or
- 15 methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of isomers, on
- 16 the property in violation of section 124.401, subsection 1.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 This bill requires the disclosure statement for real estate
- 19 transactions under Code section 558A.4 to include information
- 20 relating to the previous manufacture of amphetamine, its salts,
- 21 isomers, or salts of isomers, or methamphetamine, its salts,
- 22 isomers, or salts of isomers, on the property in violation of
- 23 Code section 124.401.
- 24 Code section 714.8 provides that a contract seller who
- 25 intentionally provides inaccurate information with regard
- 26 to any matter required to be disclosed under Code section
- 27 558A.4 is guilty of a fraudulent practice. The amount of
- 28 money or value of property or services involved determines the
- 29 applicable criminal penalty, ranging from a simple misdemeanor
- 30 to a class "C" felony.
