A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the transportation and storage of firearms
- 2 in privately owned motor vehicles.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **724.31 Transportation and storage** 2 of firearms privately owned motor vehicles.
- 3 1. Except as provided in subsection 4, a person who lawfully
- 4 possesses a firearm may transport or store such firearm in
- 5 a locked, privately owned motor vehicle in any parking lot,
- 6 parking garage, or other designated parking area.
- Except as provided in subsection 3, a property owner,
- 8 tenant, public or private employer, business entity, or
- 9 any agent or employee thereof, shall not be liable in any
- 10 civil action for damages resulting from or arising out of an
- 11 occurrence involving a firearm transported or stored pursuant
- 12 to this section.
- 3. A property owner, tenant, public or private employer,
- 14 business entity, or any agent or employee thereof, shall not
- 15 prohibit a person from transporting or storing a firearm
- 16 pursuant to subsection 1. However, this section shall not
- 17 prohibit a public or private employer or business entity from
- 18 adopting a policy specifying that a firearm stored in a locked,
- 19 privately owned motor vehicle on property controlled by the
- 20 public or private employer or business entity be placed within
- 21 a locked case or container within the vehicle.
- 22 4. This section shall not apply to the following:
- 23 a. Any property where the possession of a firearm is
- 24 prohibited under state or federal law.
- 25 b. Any vehicle owned or leased by a public or private
- 26 employer or business entity and used by an employee thereof in
- 27 the course of the employee's business if access to the parking
- 28 area is restricted or limited through the use of a fence, gate,
- 29 security station, signage, or other means of restricting or
- 30 limiting general public access onto the parking area and if any
- 31 of the following applies:
- 32 (1) The public or private employer or business entity
- 33 provides facilities for the temporary storage of unloaded
- 34 firearms.
- 35 (2) The public or private employer or business entity

- 1 provides an alternative parking area, which is reasonably close
- 2 to the main parking area, in which employees and other persons
- 3 are allowed to transport or store firearms in locked, privately
- 4 owned motor vehicles pursuant to this section.
- 5 EXPLANATION
- 6 This bill relates to the transportation and storage of
- 7 firearms in privately owned motor vehicles.
- 8 The bill provides that except as otherwise provided in the
- 9 bill, a person who lawfully possesses a firearm may transport
- 10 or store such firearm in a locked, privately owned motor
- 11 vehicle in any parking lot, parking garage, or other designated
- 12 parking area.
- 13 The bill provides that, except as otherwise provided in the
- 14 bill, a property owner, tenant, public or private employer, or
- 15 business entity, or any agent or employee thereof, shall not
- 16 be liable in any civil action for damages resulting from or
- 17 arising out of an occurrence involving a firearm transported
- 18 or stored under the provisions of the bill. A property owner,
- 19 tenant, public or private employer, or business entity, or any
- 20 agent or employee thereof, shall not prohibit a person from
- 21 transporting or storing a firearm; however, a public or private
- 22 employer or business entity may adopt a policy specifying that
- 23 a firearm stored in a locked, privately owned motor vehicle
- 24 on property controlled by the public or private employer or
- 25 business entity be placed within a locked case or container
- 26 within the vehicle.
- 27 The bill does not apply to any property where the possession
- 28 of firearms is prohibited under state or federal law or any
- 29 vehicle owned or leased by a public or private employer or
- 30 business entity and used by an employee thereof in the course
- 31 of the employee's business if access to the parking area
- 32 is restricted or limited through the use of a fence, gate,
- 33 security station, signage, or other means of restricting
- 34 or limiting general public access onto the parking area if
- 35 the public or private employer or business entity provides

- 1 facilities for the temporary storage of unloaded firearms or
- 2 the public or private employer or business entity provides an
- 3 alternative parking area reasonably close to the main parking
- 4 area in which employees and other persons are allowed to
- 5 transport or store firearms in locked, privately owned motor
- 6 vehicles pursuant to the bill.
