- 1 Section 1. Section 602.4201, subsection 1, Code Supplement 2 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- The supreme court may prescribe all rules of pleading,
- 4 practice, evidence, and procedure, and the forms of process,
- 5 writs, and notices, for all proceedings in all courts of
- 6 this state, for the purposes of simplifying the proceedings
- 7 and promoting the speedy determination of litigation upon
- 8 its merits. The supreme court may also prescribe rules
- 9 allowing judicial officers, at the discretion of the judicial
- 10 officer, to conduct hearings using video conferencing to meet
- 11 statutory in-person requirements. The rules prescribing video
- 12 conferencing shall allow a party to make an application to the
- 13 court requesting the hearing be in the presence of the judicial
- 14 officer.
- 15 EXPLANATION
- 16 This bill relates to conducting court hearings by video 17 conference.
- 18 Under the bill, the supreme court may prescribe rules
- 19 allowing a judicial officer, at the discretion of such officer,
- 20 to conduct hearings using video conferencing to meet statutory
- 21 in-person requirements. If a judicial officer orders a hearing
- 22 by video conferencing, the rules shall allow a party to make an
- 23 application requesting the hearing be in the presence of the
- 24 judicial officer.
